YARDAGE CLASSES & SCORING ARE DEFINED ON BACK PAGE IN THE REGULATIONS SHOOTING STAKES WITH MAX YARDAGES OF 35, 40, 45, 50 & 55 YARDS (+/- 3 YARDS). TEAMS CONSIST OF 2 ARCHERS THAT CAN SHOOT EITHER THE SAME OR DIFFERENT CLASSES. TEAMS MUST REGISTER THE SHOOTER'S CLASS IDENTIFICATION WHEN REGISTERING.

(\$2400 IN PAYOUT AMOUNTS ARE GUARANTEED IF REGISTRATION IS FILLED)

Rules and Regulations

Yardage classes are defined below.

35 yard max = FHC, SFHC, YMR 13/14,
40 yard max = HC, SHC, MHC, AHC, SMC, YMR 15-17, FBR, FBO, FSR
45 yard max = PHC, MBR, MSR, MCBH, BBO
50 yard max = MBO, SPM, PSR
55 yard max = PMR, PRF

Teams can consist of 2 archers shooting different classes!!

All archers will shoot from their designated shooting stake. (If you have any questions about the classes, please text or call (717)205-7877

Target scoring

- 1. All targets will have IBO inserts and the front vital is scored.
 - 2. The best arrow for each team will be recorded.
 - 3. The center "X" ring will be worth 12 points.
- 4. If you and your partner both hit the "X" ring, 14 points will be awarded.
 - 5. Maximun points per target is 14, but 12, 10, 8, 5 and 0 are in play.
- 6. If a team has entered the calcutta, every "X" ring hit is worth 1 towards the side pot.

Course rules

- 1. Registration is from 7:00 am until 8:30 am at the pavilion.
- 2. A safety meeting will be held around 8:50 am and archers will be put into their shooting groups. Score cards and starting targets will be handed out at that time.
- 3. All archers will walk to their designated starting target on the course with their peir group after the safety meeting.
- 4. Once all archers are at their targets, they can choose who will be recording the scores and who will be calling the scores. <u>Double scoring will apply.</u>
- 4. After all 21 targets are shot, shooters will then add up their scores, sign off their cards and turn them back in at the pavilion.
 - 5 While scores are being checked, food and drinks will be available.
- <u>6. All tie breakers will go to a teams "X" count and then to the 1^{st} team scoring a 14 if needed.</u>
 - 7. Once all scores are checked and flights are determined, Payouts will be handed out.
