


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


# Pencil Case Stickers



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


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


# Pencil Case Stickers



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




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#### Instructions

The above resources can be laminated for repeated use. I have included 2 pencil cases with colour round the edges only as an option if people want to reduce the amount of coloured ink used. The activity could be used in two ways:

- 1) As a simple pencil case decorating activity where the child chooses the different pictures to decorate their pencil case.
- 2) As a listening activity where the child is given different instructions to follow to decorate the pencil case. See examples below for instructions at different levels of understanding.

#### 1 key word instructions

Materials needed: Several different stickers to choose from (e.g. heart, star, butterfly), one pencil case.

Example instructions:

Get a <u>heart</u>.

Get a spider.

Get something <u>red</u>.

The child can then stick or velcro the sticker on the pencil case.

#### 2 key word instructions

Materials needed: Several of each sticker available (e.g. 3 hearts, 3 stars, 3 butterflies), one pencil case.

Example instructions:

Get two hearts.

Get a **heart** and a **star**.

The child can then stick or velcro the stickers on the pencil case.

#### 3 key word instructions

Materials needed: Several of each sticker available (e.g. 3 spiders, 3 dinosaurs, 3 faces), and both pencil cases.

Example instructions:

Put <u>two spiders</u> on the <u>purple</u> pencil case.

Put <u>three</u> <u>dinosaurs</u> on the <u>blue</u> pencil case.

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
