

Creating Opportunities for Communication

Try setting up some of the situations below and then WAITING for your child to communicate with you!



Put favourite toys in view but out of reach. For example, on a high shelf

Put favourite food or toys in a pot your child can't open on their own





Offer things bit by bit - one crisp, puzzle piece or brick at a time

Offer choices throughout the day - 'Apple or banana?', 'Car or ball?'





Use toys your child can't work on their own like balloons, bubbles and wind-up toys

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
