

This fall also brings a meaningful new partnership: for the **first time ever, the Aerie and Auxiliary are working together** to support the **Capuchin Soup Kitchen in Detroit** — a local organization doing **life-changing work** for our community.

The Capuchin operate two soup kitchens, but their mission goes far beyond food. One of their programs, **Jefferson House**, offers **residential drug rehabilitation services**, helping individuals overcome addiction and rebuild their lives. Through compassion and structure, they help residents heal and find hope again.

The Capuchin also support those re-entering society after incarceration with opportunities to **learn** Baking (they have a bakery), **build resumes**, and receive **housing and transportation assistance** — including bus tokens to help get to job interviews or new employment.

They run a **children's summer camp** for kids experiencing hardship, and even a **grocery-style soup kitchen** where families in need can pick up fresh groceries by the pound — all free of charge.

If you're ever near **St. Bonaventure Church**, be sure to stop by the tomb of **Blessed Solanus Casey**, a place of reflection and healing. They also offer **healing Masses every Wednesday and Sunday**, open to all. We were honored to have some of the Capuchin monks join us at our corn roast, and we hope to see more of them at upcoming events.




