Natural Plaster Workshop Sunday, February 23rd, 10am - 4pm

Join us for an opportunity to learn and advance your natural building skills as we make and apply natural, clay-based plaster to our new wattle-and-daub market shed. Led by local natural building expert <u>Sage Stoneman</u>, and our lead carpenter and arborist Abudu.

Earthen based plaster is used to seal a wall or structure in order to resist decay and weathering. It is often made from a mix of clay, sand, water, and a plant-based fiber. Our mix will include cattail seed pods harvested from our land, as well as local clay. The workshop will include guidance on how to find and source clay.

Sauerkraut Making Workshop Saturday, March 8th, 10am - 12pm

Join us for a morning of Sauerkraut Fermentation 101, led by our resident home fermentation enthusiast, Natalie. Sauerkraut is a probiotic and vitamin C rich food, made by fermenting cabbage with only salt.

Natalie makes sauerkraut every two weeks for her family. She's excited to share the wisdom she's gleaned and to spread the joy and health benefits of homemade vegetable ferments.

In order to keep costs down for attendees, this is a "bring your own" supplies workshop - participants will bring their own cabbage, knife, cutting board, large bowl, glass weight, kitchen scale, sea salt, and jar.




Tree Pruning Workshop Recap


