As you may remember, we have expanded our sponsorship program into the slums of Nairobi, Kenya. We are now supporting three schools in the slums by providing lunch every Saturday, 52 weeks a year, thanks to some very generous donors.

Last Saturday we fed over 1,350 kids (see above)!!



In Rakwaro, Kenya (see above and below), we are providing a Bible lesson every Sunday **plus a healthy fresh fruit snack for over 200 kids!** We are also sending each child with rice and beans for their lunches for the entire week.

Devi Saladhi (#I-7)




India DOB: 10/01/2006


Medapati Sunny (#I-11)
