2021: DISASTER RELIEF UPDATE

GIFTS WERE DISTRIBUTED TO FOUR PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE AREA AND LOCAL FAMILIES IN NEED!



TOTAL DISASTER RELIEF GIFTS DISTRIBUTED TO-DATE: \$85.5K!











Disaster Relief efforts continued as our Phase 3 efforts reached Almeda Fire Victims at the Phoenix-Talent School District, Armadillo Technical Institute, Kids Unlimited and Logos Public Charter Schools!

These four schools received approximately 95 Disaster Relief gift packages from Helping Hands International, which included a \$500 gift card, Bible and Christmas card. In total, we distributed approximately \$47,500 to Fire Victims through these schools - praise the Lord!

DISASTER RESPONSE EFFORTS

Phase 1: Food Distribution Teams - served over 12k meals in partnership with the Salvation Army!

Phase 2: Sifting Teams - helped approximately 65 families by sifting through their destroyed homes, giving out out Bibles and \$500 gift cards!

Phase 3: School Outreach - helped approximately 95 families by giving out \$500 gift cards and Bibles!

Phase 4: On-Time Gifts - started helping families (like the Boeme family below) by giving out onetime gifts and Bibles.

HELP FOR A LOCAL HERO



LIKE MANY SOUTHERN OREGON FIRE SURVIVORS, SHEHAN BOEME'S FAMILY WAS STILL LIVING IN A HOTEL SIX MONTHS AFTER THE BLAZE, UNSURE HOW HE WOULD AFFORD A MORE PERMANENT SHELTER.

This is a picture of Shehan Boeme, who was featured on KOBI Channel 5 for helping residents at the Bear Lake Estates escape the September 2020 Almeda fire, which in combination with the Obenchain fire, destroyed more than 2,500 homes in Southern Oregon.

Like many Southern Oregon Fire Survivors, Shehan Boeme's family was still living in a hotel six months after the blaze, unsure how he would afford a more permanent shelter.

Helping Hands International, Inc. reached out to Shehan's family in January, after receiving an online Needs Assessment form. And, we are happy to share that after several phone calls, emails, text messages and in-person meetings, HHI decided to award Shehan's family our largest single Fire Victim gift to-date, namely \$5k, to help their family purchase a vehicle and trailer.

Thanks to this one-time gift of \$5k, Shehan's family of 6 was able to move out of the hotel and start saving for a more permanent residence.

This family is still in need of a home but, this gift was one step in the right direction and brought much needed financial relief to their family.



MOURNING WITH OUR FRIENDS

We experienced two deaths in the Rakwaro Village in recent months and wanted to pause and remember their lives.

The first was Silas Odhiambo, who was approximately 11 years old when he died. He was faithfully supported by a HHI Child Sponsor and loved by both those in the Village and by HHI Volunteers who spent time visiting him in person!

The second was Erick Odhiambo, who was an 8th grader when he died. He was not part of the HHI Child Sponsorship program but was known well in the Village and spent time with our Volunteers. Here he is pictured with his Grandmother.

Erick lived with his Uncle Shadrack and suffered from sickle cell anemia. He was receiving medicine from the States to address his health condition but, due to COVID-19, the life-giving packages stopped reaching him.


