**Charitable Giving Options for the Slovenian Catholic Center**

Supporting The Dom at the Slovenian Catholic Center helps sustain our facilities, traditions, and programs so that future generations can continue to gather, celebrate, and build community together. Please consider the following Charitable Giving Options to help support our Dom:

**Cash Gifts**

Cash donations are the most straightforward way to support the Center. If you itemize deductions, cash gifts may generally be deducted up to 60% of adjusted gross income (AGI). They are simple, flexible, and allow the Center to immediately put your generosity to work.

**Appreciated Stock or Securities**

Donating appreciated stocks, mutual funds, or ETFs may provide significant tax advantages. You may be able to deduct the full market value of the investment while avoiding capital gains tax that would normally be due if the asset were sold.

**Donor-Advised Funds (DAFs)**

A Donor-Advised Fund allows you to contribute cash or securities, receive an immediate tax deduction, and recommend grants to charities like the Slovenian Catholic Center over time. Many donors use DAFs as a flexible way to plan long-term charitable giving.

**Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs)**

For individuals age 70½ or older, funds can be transferred directly from an IRA to a qualified charity. The distribution counts toward required minimum distributions while not being included in taxable income, which may help reduce overall taxable income.

# MAKE YOUR OWN KRUHOV NARASTEK (BREAD PUDDING)



## INGREDIENTS

### Bread Pudding Ingredients

6–8 slices brioche (or white bread),  
cut into 1-inch cubes

Turbinado or coarse sugar, for  
topping

Vanilla ice cream & flaky sea salt, for  
serving

### Brown Sugar Butter Sauce

#### Ingredients

½ cup butter

½ cup brown sugar

½ cup granulated sugar

½ cup buttermilk

1 tsp vanilla

½ tsp baking soda

### Custard Ingredients

¾ cup buttermilk (or whole milk)

¾ cup heavy (whipping) cream

3 Tbsp brown sugar

3 Tbsp granulated sugar

1 tsp vanilla or 1 package vanilla sugar

1 tsp cinnamon

Pinch of salt

3 eggs

1½ Tbsp melted butter



# INSTRUCTIONS

## **Step 1: Prepare the bread**

Preheat the oven to 175°C (350°F). Grease and line a 9×5-inch baking pan. If the bread isn't already dry, spread the cubes on a tray and toast for 7-10 minutes, just until lightly golden.

If the bread is very fresh, place it in a 400°F (200°C) oven for 7-10 minutes to dry it out.

## **Step 2: Make the custard**

In a bowl, whisk together buttermilk, cream, both sugars, vanilla, cinnamon, and salt. Add the eggs and melted butter and whisk until smooth and well combined.

## **Step 3: Assemble & rest**

Place the bread cubes into the prepared pan. Pour the custard evenly over the bread, pressing gently so everything is soaked. Sprinkle with coarse sugar if using. Let rest for 30 minutes at room temperature, or refrigerate overnight for a richer texture.

## **Step 4: Bake**

Bake for 45-55 minutes, until the top is golden and the center is just slightly wobbly. The inside should feel soft and custardy.

## **Step 5: Make the brown sugar butter sauce**

In a saucepan with tall sides, melt the butter with both sugars and buttermilk over medium heat. Bring to a gentle boil and simmer for 2-3 minutes. Remove from heat and whisk in the vanilla and baking soda – it will foam.

## **Step 6: Serve**

Slice the kruhov narastek while warm. Drizzle generously with the brown sugar butter sauce. Top with vanilla ice cream and a pinch of flaky sea salt.

## **Tips & Notes**

Traditionally, kruhov narastek is served with vanilla sauce or a dusting of sugar. This version is slightly richer, but still rooted in tradition.

Buttermilk substitution: Use kislo mleko or plain yogurt thinned with milk.

Bread alternatives: Day-old rolls or simple white bread work perfectly if brioche isn't available.

For deeper flavor, let the bread soak in the custard overnight in the fridge.
