

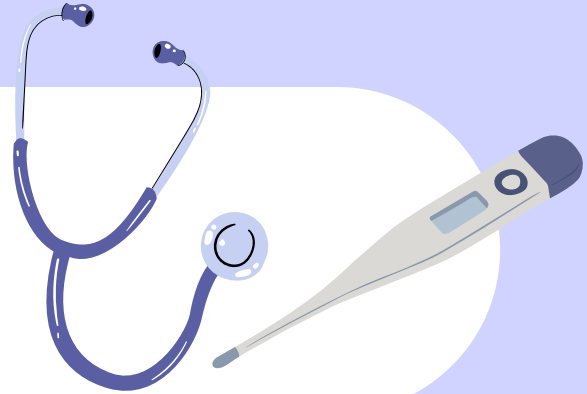

TEMPERATURE

Oral: 97.4°F – 99.6°F
Rectal: 98.2°F – 100.7°F
Axillary: 94.6°F – 97.3°F
Temporal: 95.3°F – 98°F
Tympanic: 96.9°F – 100.2°F



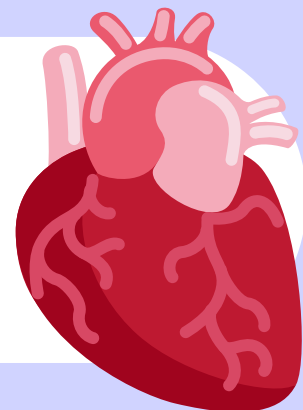
BLOOD PRESSURE

Infant (varies by age): 87-105/53-66
1-3 years old: 95-105/53-66
3-5 years old: 95-110/56-70
6-12 years old: 97-112/57-71
13-18 years old: 112-128/66-80
Adults: <120/80



HEART RATE

Infant: 100-140 BPM
1-3 years old: 80-130 BPM
3-5 years old: 80-110 BPM
6-12 years old: 70-100 BPM
13+: 60-100 BPM



RESPIRATORY RATE

Under 1 month: 30-60
1 month-1 year: 26-60
1-10 years old: 14-50
11-18 years old: 12-22
Adult: 12-20
