
5 LEAD EKG PLACEMENT

What is a 5 Lead EKG?

- Consists of <u>4 limb leads</u> and <u>1 precordial lead</u>
- · Monitors electrical activity in the heart
- Provides continuous monitoring (Telemetry)

Other Forms of Heart Monitoring:

- EKG (12 Lead, Stress Test, Signal-Averaged)
- Holter Monitor
- Loop Monitor
- Mobile Cardiac Telemetry

Types of Abnormal Heart Rhythms:

- Atrial Fibrillation
- Atrial Flutter
- Paroxysmal Supraventricular Tachycardia
- Ventricular Tachycardia
- Ventricular Fibrillation

Symptoms of Arrhythmias:

- · Chest pain
- Palpitations
- Shortness of breath
- Dizziness
