### **CONSENT AGENDA**

- Nutrient Grant- DeAnna Wynn reported she is still waiting for a final response from the Department of Ecology regarding use of funds for the Comprehensive Plan.
- Lift Station 8 Easement- DeAnna Wynn provided the attorney's response regarding the easement. The commissioners directed her to have the attorney prepare a letter.
- ADUs Update on Covered breezeway No update at this time. Staff will continue to investigate
  illegal ADUs and meet with Skagit County Planning to discuss communication practices on building
  permits.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Manhole Repair Insurance Claim The commissioners were presented with a letter from CIAW regarding assignment of the claim manager.
- Watershed Management / Lake Algae There was a discussion regarding the potential possibility of the Sewer District entering an interlocal agreement to assist with algae control in Big Lake. The attorney's comments were discussed. It was decided that citing RCW 57.08.005(10) in the comprehensive plan would allow the district to participate in the future if funding was available.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the addition of RCW 57.08.005(10) to the comprehensive plan. All were in favor and the motion carried 3-0.
