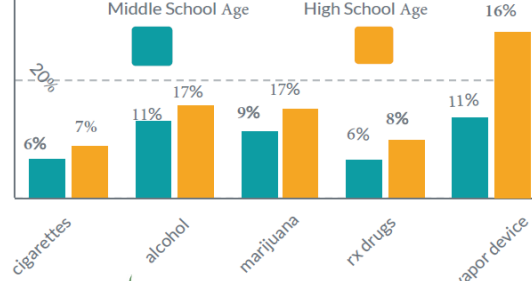

Youth 2023



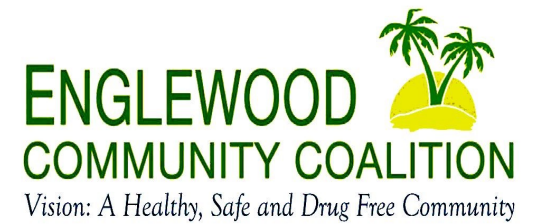
**43%** of Englewood high school aged youth report that they think it would be wrong for them to use marijuana.

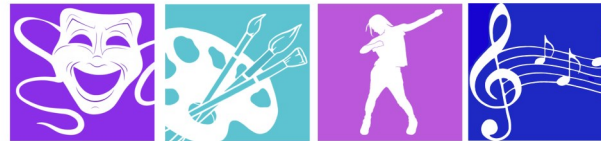
## NO LIMITS - The Arts
