A few proposals were presented to address tee times/slots, to maximize tee times being filled. Here's a summary of the two approaches:

First Approach

- **Simplified structure:** Tightens the tee time reservation process and introduces a cancellation fee.
- **Key details:**
 - Tee times can be booked 4 weeks in advance.
 - Reserved slots for CKMGA are specific to Saturdays (7:00–10:30 AM) and Sundays (7:00–9:30 AM, minus R'Ville times).
 - Public access begins Monday/Tuesday of the play week.
 - Late cancellations (after registration closes) incur a greens fee unless the slot is filled.
 - Fee must be paid before participating in the next event.
- **Focus:** Simplifies administration while enforcing accountability with minimal disruption.

Second Approach

- **More complex structure:** Adds layers of administration for better efficiency and more public access.
- **Key details:**
 - Tee times can be booked 4 weeks in advance.
 - Uncommitted tee times are released to the public by Monday/Tuesday of the play week.
 - Reserved slots for CKMGA remain the same (Saturday 7:00–10:30 AM; Sunday 7:00–9:30 AM, minus R'Ville times).
 - Confirmed foursomes (one week out) get priority, and groups of fewer than four are subject to grouping and time adjustments.
 - Chronic dropouts or last-minute changes are monitored and addressed.
 - Late cancellations (within one week) incur greens fees unless the slot is filled by Thursday/Friday.
 - Fee must be paid before participating in the next event.
- **Focus:** Balances public access and efficient group management with stricter policies for participation.

In short, the **First Approach** is simpler with fewer administrative changes, while the **Second Approach** introduces additional management layers to optimize tee time usage and groupings. Both approaches aim to enforce cancellation accountability.
