**** In Attendance**

Treasurer Report (as of 12/3/2025):

Current Balance: \$3,818.70

Hole in One Pool: \$1,230.00

Hole in One Balance will carry-over into 2026, but members will need to re-up to get into the pool.

Election Results(Thank you to the 65 members that voted!):

- **Handicap Chair** - Tom Falkowski defeated Greg Conklin in the race for Handicap Chair. Congratulations Tom and thank you Greg for your service!
- **Skins Chair** - Approved to add this position to the Board and will be filled by Tony Salvatore for 2026.
- **Term Limits** - This item did not pass so the term limits currently listed in the by-laws will remain in place. We will work to clarify what the purpose of this vote was over the next year and likely put it back on the ballot next year.

Membership:

2026 Dues Increase: Dues will increase \$5.00 from \$135 in 2025 to \$140 in 2026.

- Increase is to offset cost increases in both Golf Genius Subscription and GHIN Fee.

Membership Cap: 2026 Membership will be capped at 275 Members.

- Current Members will have the option to renew prior to February 15, 2026. After that, New Members will be accepted until we hit the 275 mark. Any applications after that will be waitlisted.
- 2026 Applications will be reviewed by the board to verify that member was in good standing in 2025 prior to approval.
- In 2025 we had roughly 80 members play in under 5 tournaments with many members playing in no tournaments.

Membership Survey: 103 Responses(**THANK YOU!**) out of 312 Members.

- Board is currently reviewing the results and developing action items from the survey

Tournaments:

- There will be a Minimum requirement to play in at least 10 CKMGA Tournaments in 2026. Your 2027 Membership will be dependent on meeting this requirement. There will be no pre-pay for these tournaments.

Tee Committee:

- Men's Club Gold Tees will continue to be used in 2026 as they were in 2025. These allowed for the course to play to the yardage on the card.

Sign-up and Cancellation Policies:

Starting in 2026, we will have a new sign-up and cancellation policy in effect. These policies are being put in place due to an extraordinary amount of late cancellations in 2025 by members which has forced us to put the policies in place to prevent this from happening moving forward. As part of the application process in 2026 you will be agreeing to adhere to these policies.

Sign-up policy:

The policy is as follows:

- Signup via GolfGenius will be available two weeks in advance. The exact time you choose, may not be guaranteed(See Below)
- The men's club is responsible for filling all tee-times between the Core Hours of 7:30AM and 9:30AM with **Foursomes**
 - If you sign up outside this time frame, and we have spots available during that Core time, the Pro-shop will shift your tee-time to fill those open slots
 - If you are not signed up as a foursome, the Pro-shop has the right to move you in with another group to fill a foursome. For example, Two Twosomes will be combined into a Foursome
- Communication will be sent out by the Pro-shop on **Monday or Tuesday** to let you know you are signed up for that week's tournaments. If you are not able to play, you must cancel by **Wednesday** to avoid penalty. See Cancellation Policy Below.
- We have been using this pre-notification of play for the Birdie Train so far this winter and it has been successful.

Cancellation Policy:

- **Penalty for Cancellation:** If you do not cancel by the **Wednesday** prior to the tournament, you will be responsible for either finding a member to take your spot; or you will be subject to paying the Greens Fees for that round which will be given to the course. Failure to pay the penalty will subject you to a board review and possible suspension and/or termination from the CKMGA.
- Please ensure when you are signing up that you are aware of the type of tournament you are signing up for is and that if you are signing up more than just yourself, your group is also aware and willing to play. If any of those players don't show up or cancel late, they will be subject to the penalty noted above.
 - Golf Genius sends an email out when a member gets signed up(either on their own or by another person) and the pro-shop will send a reminder out by **Monday or Tuesday** the week of the tournament, so there is plenty of opportunity to remove yourself if you don't want to play.

The CKMGA Member application will be modified to reflect adherence to these policies and the CKMGA Membership guide will also be updated.
