**A 30-minute flight in a Vietnam veteran Bell UH-1H Helicopter 'Huey 509'  
(UK Reg: G-UHIH) for up to 4 people**



A unique opportunity to experience a flight in a Vietnam veteran Bell UH-1H Helicopter 'Huey 509' for up to 4 people.

The Bell UH-1 or 'Huey' is one of the most famous helicopters in the world. It is to helicopters what the Spitfire and the P51 Mustang are to fixed wing aircraft. The Huey's most famous role will be remembered as the Air Assault and Medivac operations in the Vietnam War between 1962 and 1975. They flew 36,145,000 sorties during the conflict. Somewhere in the region of 2600 Hueys were based in Vietnam.

Huey 509 is a genuine Vietnam veteran that has undergone a full restoration - see the links on [www.huey.co.uk](http://www.huey.co.uk) dedicated to the brave American military personnel who relied on the Huey 'to bring them home' and for details of the restoration.

Huey 509 is regularly seen at airshows and events as a flying or static display. It flew at the Blackpool and Southport airshows in 2017.
