ON HWY 49 in town, look for the GOLD FLAT Rd OVER PASS, HEAD EAST right ON GOLD FLAT Rd., at stop SIGN AT the east end of GOLD FLAT, turn right onto GRACIE ROAD. About 3/4 miles, turn left on Banner Mtn Trail.

Competition open to: Any eligible competitor you need not be a member of the NRA, CMP or the sponsoring club. All competitors must have a notarized "Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement" on file at the sponsoring club or present at registration.

Entry Fee: Fee charged to all shooters, \$15.00

Entries Close: Time the sponsoring club will no longer take entries, 9:20 AM.

Firing Starts: Time the match begins, 10 AM Sharp

Rules: Current Edition of CMP Rules. Accommodation for handicap will be made available. Covid rules will be observed.

Course of Fire: 100 yard, HIGH POWER RIFLE.

5 sets. 1: PRACTICE; 10 rounds in 5 minutes. 2: STANDING, Slow Fire, 20 Rounds in 20 minutes. Single fire loading. 3: SITTING, 10 rounds in 1 minute, with a magazine change. 4: PRONE, RAPID FIRE, 10 rounds in 70 seconds, with one magazine change. 5: PRONE, Slow Fire, single loading, 10 rounds in 10 minutes.+++Rifles qualifying; AR 15, and M1 Garand, M1A1, M1 Carbine styles. OPEN SIGHTS, or handicapped with a fixed no more than 4X scope.

Awards: Awards the club will be awarding, MEDALS. And a Certificate of Achievement will be also awarded.
