JOAD is a nationwide program where certified coaches provide instruction for youth archers to help them progress in the sport at their own pace. Whether you are new to archery or an experienced archer, JOAD has what you need! You'll learn important skills, play exciting games and earn awards for developing fundamental skills and scoring achievements. JOAD clubs offer training and event preparation for all archery disciplines and we have equipment for you to use, so you can try archery first before investing in equipment.

Who Can Join?

Archery is a sport that has no limits: age, gender or ability. We offer barebow, recurve and compound archers the opportunity to learn range safety and proper shooting technique in an environment that also fosters focus, increased self-confidence, and team building skills. JOAD is open to any youth archer aged 8 to 20 and is designed to grow with the archer. Introductory JOAD classes teach the fundamentals of proper shooting form; as the young archer develops, they will learn more advanced techniques.
