of the Master Association, and on the alleyways, sidewalks and driveways for the Ranch (Alley-load) and Patio (RAP) areas of the Association.

Please be courteous and clear your sidewalk to prevent slips and falls by students and general walkers. The Town's municipal code requires the removal of snow and ice within 48 hours of when the snowfall stops.
