

It was noted that compensation with being new, full time, with housing allowance, but no health insurance will be comparable to Pastor Barb had more experience but was ¾ time with parsonage and health insurance. Pastor Asher will be here Nov 27th for a service of beginning for Vicar Amy. We also need 3 people for the parish committee-will announce during service. Holiday church services will be Thanksgiving Eve at MM and Christmas Eve at WH at 5:30. Motion by Gary 2nd by Dina to have no service on Christmas Day. Motion carried.

Mt Morris Holden Lutheran Church Council Sept 12, 2022 Meeting.

Meeting called to order by Deb Simonson at 6:45 pm

<u>Attendance:</u> Present were Bonnie Starkweather, Wayne Anderson, Deb Simonson, Greg Foster, Dan Scharnhourst, Craig Starkweather. Absent: Laurie Jarvis, Kris Peterson,

<u>Member wishing to address the Council:</u> Tara Anderson was present to address the council concerning the 2022 Christmas Dinner Project to be held at the Mt Morris Camp and Conference Center on December 25th (Christmas Day) at 12 noon.

She also spoke about a display unit for the confirmation pictures. She has found a wall unit with flip frames to display our yearly pictures of confirmation groups. The cost would be about \$160 for 5 frames to display 20 pictures. Motion was made, seconded and carried to purchase these flip photo frames..

Agenda: Motion made and seconded and carried to approve the agenda as printed.

Building and Grounds: Greg F. reported that Home Comfort Solutions has begun converting our gas furnaces to natural gas.

The door to the Janitor closet was scrapping the carpet and has been trimmed to a clear the flooring.

Heavy rains have caused some flooding of the floors in the kitchen area and soaked into carpeting in the hallway and dining area. Two drain hoses have been installed to drain the water away from the church foundation. We may need to grade the soil away from the church south wall.

The gutters on the North East side near the Pastor's office have been cleaned out.

The steeple chase entry hatch has been trimmed and painted.

Greg is waiting to hear from Jenks Well Drilling as to when they will be coming to drill the well at the parsonage.

Dale Simonson will be patching nail holes and repainting the church office.

Treasures Report: Deb S reported that we have spent \$13,053.41 and we have a balance in checking of \$14,162.48

\$15,000 of excess funds were transferred from checking to our savings account. Excess was due to funding from WELCA for window project and accumulated funds due to not having regular pastoral expenses.

WELCA report: Bonnie S reported that the quilters have resumed working on quilts. 5 ladies are currently working on these quilts.

They will need to arrange to have quilts delivered to First English Lutheran Church in Wisconsin Rapids for shipping to Lutheran World Relief.

Bylaws review: Greg F reported that Pastor Joyce (supply pastor) will help with this review and make suggestions as to what needs to be changed to meet criteria in the synod model.

<u>Lay Ministry Team Report:</u> Dan S reported that he is in conversation with Pastor Joyce (supply pastor) concerning the Christmas Eve. services at 5:30 pm at West Holden and 7:00 pm at Mt. Morris and she has agreed to provide our Communion Sunday services thru November.

Motion made, seconded and carried to approve reports.

<u>Administrative Assistant Job Description:</u> Deb S reported that Laurie J Deb S, Holly H, Pam P met to review and update the Administrative Assistant Job Description. A printed copy was reviewed by council and approved pending West Holden council approval. Motion was made by Greg F Seconded by Dan S to approve the Job description. Motion Carried.

<u>JOB FUND</u>: A \$550 scholarship from the JOB Fund was requested for a Leadership class at Luther Seminary, that Dan Scharnhourst is scheduled to take. Motion was made, seconded and carried, to give Dan the scholarship.

Josie has Choledochal Cyst, which is a are congenital dilations (enlargements) of the bile ducts, a network of long tube-like structures that carry bile from the liver to the small intestine for digestion. She has Type II: Isolated diverticulum protruding from the CBD.

Josie has a Congenital Pancreatic Cyst. Congenital pancreatic cysts are extremely rare in infants and children and pose unique diagnostic and surgical challenges.

Josie has Pediatric Acute Pancreatitis. Which again is very rare in babies. Very rare, and extremely painful.

Friday 10/21/2022 Update

"Pediatric ICU – Intensive Care Unit," following all night and day time pain, extreme abdominal distention, and other unexpected surgery with Internal Radiology, along with a spike in fever, and a heart rate of over 200.

Her little body has to seal up the rupture on its own. Josie's body right now is fighting extremely hard in that, on top of everything else. Her team of 30 plus doctors are not comfortable performing the operation with how unstable she is, as they are confident they will be able to seal her back up, nor are they confident that they would be successful in the operation due to her instability.
