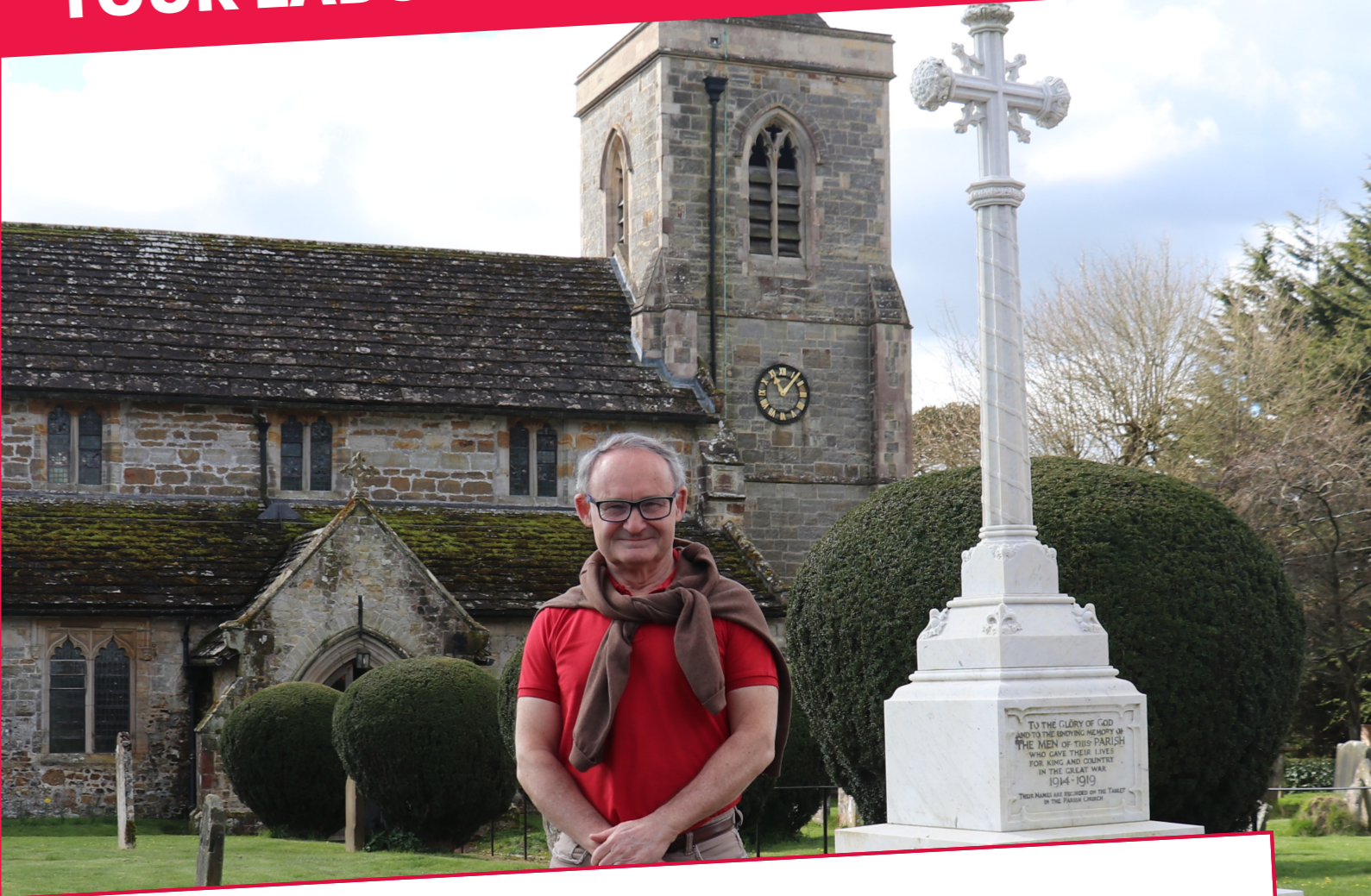

WEALDEN LABOUR WORKING FOR LOCAL RESIDENTS

Wealden Labour has proudly helped the Uckfield Food Bank and Community Fridge. We have directors of the Fridge, and have arranged collections for the Food Bank in local shops.

Unfortunately, it is not just food that people are struggling with right now. Many residents face long-term issues that have been made more painful by the current cost of living crisis. We have a plan that will help tackle these issues.

RURAL LABOUR HAS A NEW PLAN FOR WEALDEN

Partially treated sewage is running into our rivers and streams. Affordable homes for existing members of the community are not being built but expensive four and five bedroomed commuter houses are.

It does not have to be like this. Developers can be made to build more affordable homes. Infrastructure provision and environmental standards can be enforced. Meaningful consultation with existing local residents can take place.

Labour councillors would introduce a robust District Plan that would enable irresponsible planning applications to be refused and protect the heritage of our local villages.

CHAMPION AFFORDABLE HOUSING

I will vote against all housing developments that don't offer sufficient affordable housing to buy. I will also support schemes that facilitate affordable renting.

We need new houses, but our services must keep up. I will work to force developers to fund local infrastructure including buses to ease the congestion on our roads.



HELP YOUNG PEOPLE

I will work to make homes better insulated, cutting energy bills for residents and helping to tackle the climate crisis as well as the cost of living crisis.

I will challenge the short-sighted view of closing this community-funded asset and seek funding to preserve the only public swimming pool for over 10 miles.
