New + coming soon

Cocoa Legato – A chocolate-making café and live music venue in Greenwood, merging bean-to-bar craft with in-house performances. Opened in April 2025

Meat Moot – A theatrical, upscale halal restaurant from Istanbul, opening its West Coast flagship in South Lake Union (expected August 2025)

Nudibranch Coffee – Seattle's first Thai-style coffee shop, offering unique drinks like espresso-with-orange-juice, butterfly-pea matcha, and Milo mochas. (expected in October 2025)

DeLille Cellars – A Bordeaux-inspired wine tasting room and restaurant to open in University Village in fall 2025

Moto – Detroit-style, Filipino-influenced pizza café, opening its fifth location in the historic Smith Tower in fall/winter 2025

Urban Family Brewing (Waterfront location) – Ballard favorite opening a second, dog-friendly location on the Seattle waterfront in early 2026

Super Chix – A fast-casual chicken chain slated to open in early 2026 in the Maritime Building downtown

Reuben's Brews Downtown Taproom – New taproom with 28 taps and food offerings, opening early summer 2025 near Pike Place Market

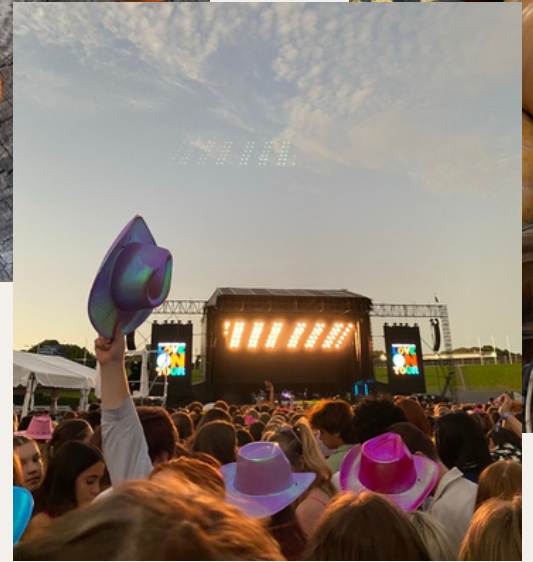

Weekend trips

MOUNT RAINIER / ASHFORD

Travel Time: 2 hours

Known for: Jaw-dropping autumn foliage framed by snow-capped peaks.

Check out: Box Canyon Trail for hidden waterfalls, Tipsoo Lake viewpoints for a sunrise or sunset picnic with fall colors.



SNOQUALMIE

Travel Time: 45 minutes

Known for: Home to stunning waterfalls and a quintessential Pacific Northwest small-town feel.

Check out: Snoqualmie Falls Market for local artisan treats, Twin Peaks-inspired hiking trails that are less crowded but scenic.



PORT TOWNSEND

Travel Time: 2 hours 30 minutes

Known for: Victorian charm, waterfront views, and a rich maritime history.

Check out: Silverwater Café tucked away from the main drag, Fort Worden State Park for fall beach walks with almost no crowds.
