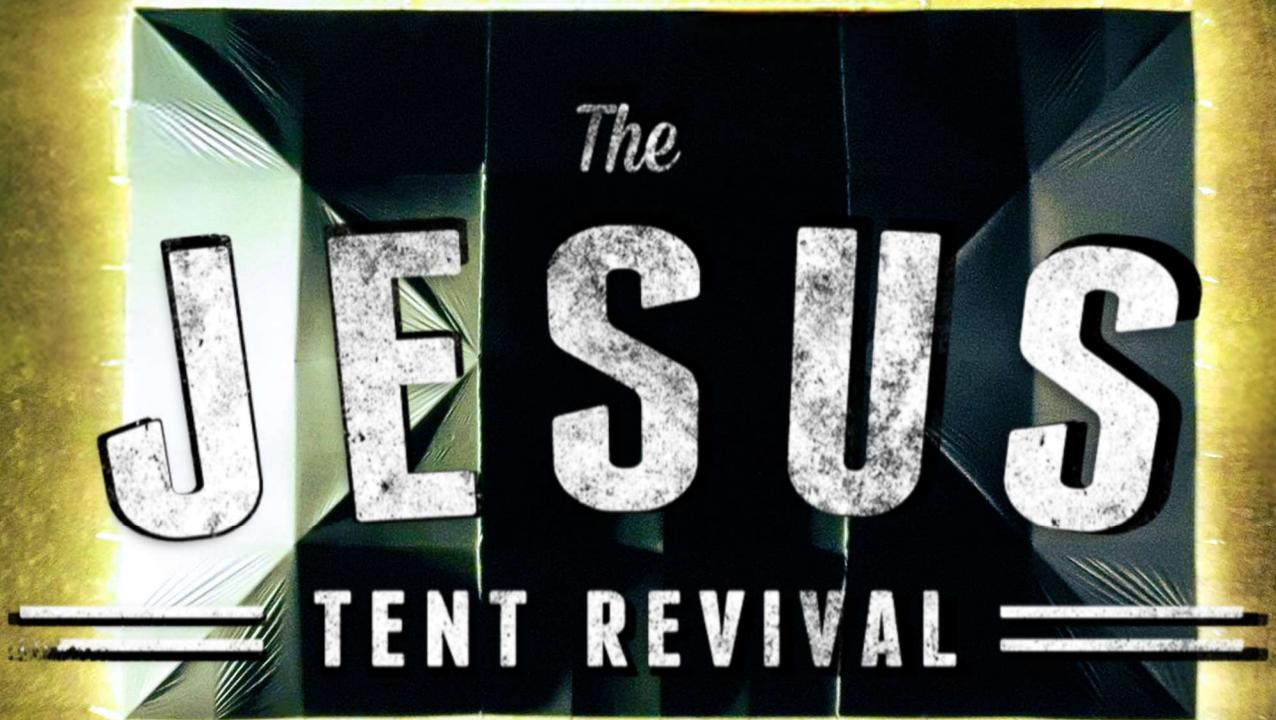

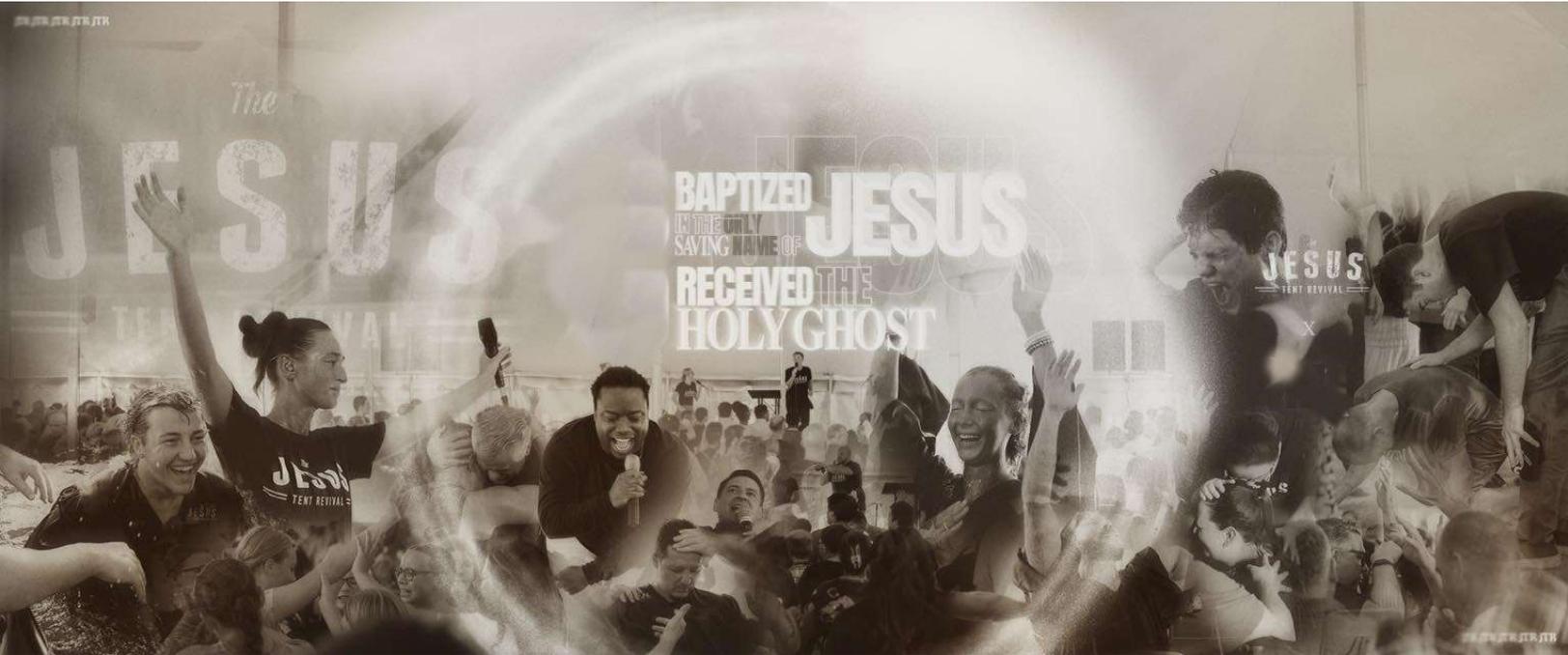

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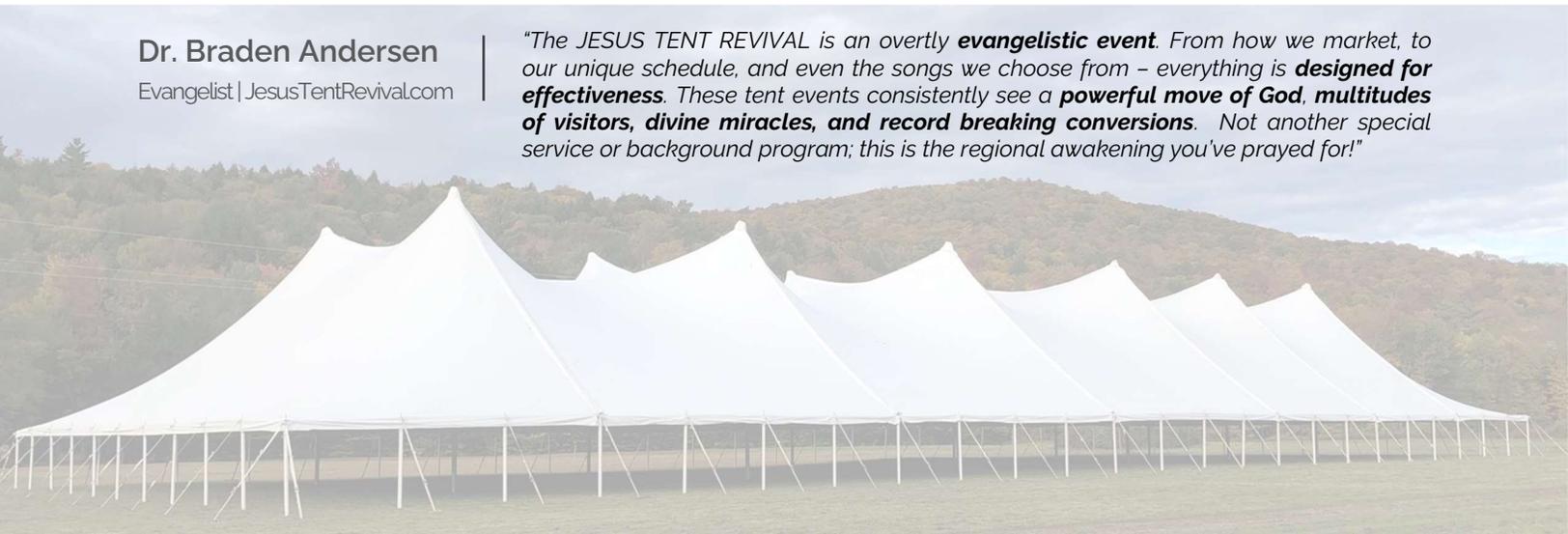
Our History

The History
FOUR YEARS AGO, PASTOR BOBBY Carter approached me with an unconventional idea. Despite never having attended a tent revival himself, he felt compelled to try to create a modernized version. During our initial conversation, he conveyed the need for an outreach evangelist experienced in crusade-style events. I felt drawn to support his vision; thus, the first “Jesus Tent Revival” was born. Since then, through numerous tents, trailers, trucks, and tractors, this initiative has evolved into a national outreach tool.

The Design
 The Jesus Tent Revival was intentionally designed as an overtly evangelistic event focusing not on any particular preacher or worship leader, but on igniting a church breakthrough and regional awakenings—a modern Azusa. Every flyer, social media invitation, yard sign, and mailer emphasized a singular idea: an encounter with Jesus. Unlike many of my other outreach events, attendees wouldn’t be coming for a free bike or a block party. Neither did we market nostalgia or novelty. Instead, Jesus Tent Revivals represent our greatest concerted effort to bring the lost to a life-altering encounter with the divine.

The Growth
 Despite facing steep learning curves in logistics and marketing, the Jesus Tent Revival has experienced significant growth. Tent capacities have expanded from accommodating 450 people to 1,700 with guests often outnumbering church members. The outreach efforts grew so successful that we had to increase to eight baptismal changing rooms and three simultaneous baptismal tanks. In fact, the growth is now constrained only by insufficient box trucks and trailers.

Similar to the Asbury Revival, we’ve witnessed unchurched individuals traveling from hours away, some even booking hotels to attend. During our last revival, we had twenty out-of-state visitors, while many locals were drawn solely by the sound of worship. Curiously, even atheists have begun attending as word spreads throughout the city. Baptizing often starts before the service and runs for hours without interruption until the lights go out.

Testimonies
 Months of prayer and fasting precede each revival, resulting in what can only be described as a sovereign move of God. Even before we arrive in town, weather patterns seem to adjust favorably for our events. Throughout the city, people



report vivid dreams of our big white tent set up on the church's field. Numerous stories circulate of individuals stumbling upon discarded invitations in trash cans or parking lots and feeling compelled to attend. During our services some have reported visions of angels, while others claim to have been guided by lights in the sky to the tent. Astonishingly, atheists have been struck by blinding lights, and some have even reported hearing divine voices.

We've witnessed miraculous healings where canes, oxygen tanks, and crutches are left behind. In one instance, a man with a terminal illness so severe that he collapsed upon arrival managed to crawl to the front for prayer, only to be baptized and filled with the Spirit, immediately regaining his health and strength. Others have reached down to find their cancerous masses vanished, while tobacco addicts have left their vices at the altar, and drug addicts were sobered at the moment of baptism.

The blind have regained their sight. One man's doctor even confirmed his unexplainable 20/20 vision the day after the revival. On another occasion, three deaf individuals were simultaneously healed. Some individuals, overwhelmed by the desire for God, refuse to even wait for a robe and were baptized in their street clothes. Many atheists and even witches have not only believed but also have been baptized and filled with the Spirit. Recently, a man who had attempted suicide was baptized and filled with the Holy Spirit. Two pastors attended with strong objections to receiving the Holy Ghost, only to receive it minutes later and return on subsequent nights, bringing their entire congregations to receive it as well.

Word Is Spreading

Our outreach efforts have transitioned from witnessing twenty-five to fifty-five baptisms to facilitating mass conversions. Hundreds are now baptized during these events, and we anticipate seeing individual revivals baptizing thousands in the near future. News of these revivals and divine encounters spreads rapidly, attracting media attention and sparking regional curiosity. For instance, when 157 people were baptized in Fort Smith, Arkansas, the local radio station interviewed Pastor Tim Sullivan to discuss the event on air. Similarly, in Belleview, Florida, news of 126 baptisms quickly spread throughout the city, prompting press

coverage and an interview with Pastor Jason Varnum, whose story made the front page of the local paper and website.

Why Might It Work?

The success of these outreach events may be in a synergy of factors.

1. Tent revivals inherently evoke spiritual intrigue and interest, offering a rare opportunity for attendees.
2. Our marketing doesn't center on a preacher or building, but on experiencing Jesus.
3. A neutral tent venue allows attendees to feel they aren't betraying a church by attending.
4. The outdoor venue is more casual in dress, minimizing intimidation.
5. Extensive prayer, fasting, promotion, outreach, and training sets an elevated level of expectation. People come for a miracle and the church comes ready to help them.
6. Tent crusades draw a demographic with greater "spiritual interest," which leads to a greater proportion of conversions and retention.
7. God honors certain environments. Regardless of a tent, great revivals need a church-wide emphasis on evangelism, deep spiritual hunger, humble leadership, and sacrificial effort. **PL**

The Preparation Process

TO DO IT RIGHT, THIS WILL PROBABLY BE THE **LARGEST** AND **HARDEST** EVENT YOUR CHURCH HAS EVER PLANNED.



Analyze your MOTIVES

The Jesus Tent Revival is not a "shot in the arm" for a dormant church, nor a member-centered novelty. This event is only for a church that is ready & desperate to reach their city! This must be the entire church's central focus.



RESEARCH the Land

Where is the tent going? What location gives the best street visibility? Can we get power and water? Does the parcel have utility lines underground that the stakes would hit? Where do we park? What permits do we need?



Pitch VISION and PRAY

For multiple months you will promote vision & build faith for **"the greatest revival this city has ever seen!"** This includes clearing the church schedule for outreach, prayer, fasting, pre-revival training, and fundraising



Plan OUTREACH

Plan to distribute at least **10,000 door hangers** & spend **thousands on boosting our pre-made invite videos**. Expect many church-wide outreach events. Reaching your city starts with every apartment, parking lot, mall, college, and busy area! Mailers and yard signs help too!



Assemble Event TEAMS

Your pastoral team and church leaders will be given a login to the hidden JesusTentRevival.com training website. For several months, your teams will review the website, plan, meet, and execute this monumental breakthrough event in your region. Get everyone involved!



LAUNCH the Event

This is not just "church outside," or a background event on the lawn of an otherwise busy church. This is a modern Azusa! Follow the planning website and expect to see a great harvest and the church never be the same! Clear the schedule and let this breakthrough take center stage!

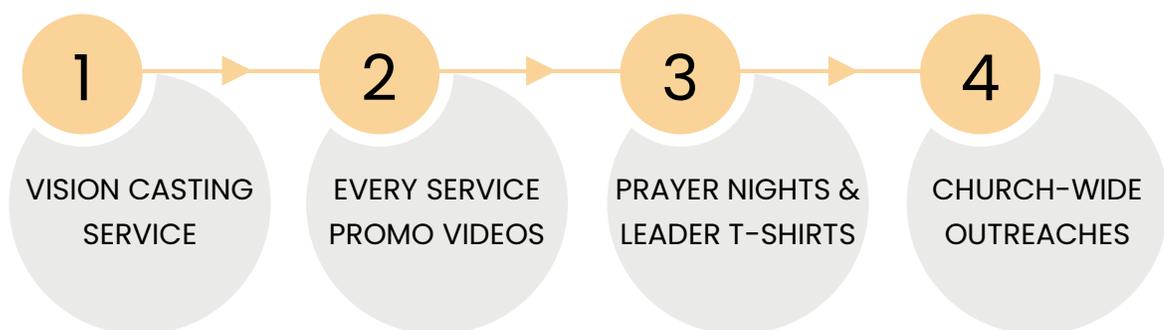

Generate Momentum in Your Church



A Tent Revival doesn't succeed by scheduling alone—it grows through **vision, leadership, messaging, and total church engagement**. When the entire church understands that this is not just an event, but an opportunity for regional impact, momentum builds. Through intentional prayer, outreach, and leadership participation, the church becomes spiritually aligned and actively invested. Momentum is created when revival remains the central focus for months (not days) leading up to the event. Every service, prayer meeting, and outreach event should reinforce expectation, urgency, and faith for breakthrough.

The Four Steps Process



Launch the revival with a dedicated service that stirs faith and expectation. Cast vision that this is not just a background event, but the beginning of regional awakening. Preach on revival and evangelism, present the vision boldly, and invite the church to invest through prayer, commitment, and a special offering (for marketing).

Keep revival in front of the church every week. Play promo videos in each service in the months leading to revival. This will be paired to the church staff concurrently posting our promotional videos on social media, per the prescribed schedule. Excitement will be generated in & out of the church.

Establish consistent prayer meetings focused on hunger for God and breakthrough. Prayer increases burden and expectation. Also, ask all leaders to forgoe the dress shirt & tie – instead wearing Tent Revival shirts during Sunday services leading to revival. These reminders create anticipation & vision.

Mobilize the entire church (from the pastor to the pew) to personally attend outreaches and invite the lost. Outreach involves every member—young & old—to take ownership. When the church actively reaches beyond its walls, excitement grows and the church is culturally ready for a harvest.

The pastoral staff should expect to personally set the vision, burden, outreach, & expectation around the event.

HOW TO SCHEDULE AN EVENT

01

Read this GUIDE and PRAY

Go through this guide in detail and pray about your church's readiness for a revival of this size. We understand the complex variables that surround readiness: spiritual, financial, evangelism, land, calendar, bandwidth, systems, culture, burden, & spiritual hunger.

02

Visit our WEBSITE and suggest DATES

Visit jesustentrevival.com/for-pastors and fill out an interest form. We use the details you submit to start working on getting a tent and team to you. Be sure to include any and all dates that could work for your event.

03

Schedule a CALL with our TEAM

We will reach out to you and schedule a call to discuss your event. We can't wait to support your vision for revival! Make sure to bring up any questions or concerns you have. We can also schedule any pre-visits or zoom calls your team may need.

Teams You Need

Once leaders are registered, **our planning website will give detailed instructions**, templates, and graphics for each team.



PRAYER TEAM

The prayer team will create a prayer and fasting calendar leading to the event. They will lead prayer meetings on the land.



GRAPHIC & SOCIAL

A team will order at least 10,000 door hangars & post all of our social media invite videos. Follow our posting schedule!



OUTREACH TEAM

Outreach planned by this team and then executed by the whole church. Print maps of apartments, parks, stores, colleges, etc.



SETUP/DOWN TEAM

Part of how we can offer tents without assigned fees is because we try not to hire secular crews. We need your help with tent setup/tear down.



WORSHIP TEAM

The worship team is critical to the success of the Tent Revival. Our planning website shows the service structure and approved song list in advance of the event.



REGISTRATION & RETENTION

Consider giving every guest a gift bag (church merch, water, bug spray, kleenex). As these are given out, the demographic information is collected for later follow up.



BAPTISM & ALTAR TEAM

A team will staff the baptism station, collecting additional information before baptism. You will show visitors how to get changed into robes, perform baptisms. Concurrently, altar teams are praying with the crowd.



SOUND & FACILITIES

The sound and facilities team will work with sound, instrument, and equipment planning. This includes coordinating pre-service sound checks with the worship team and any needed rentals (generator, stage lights, bathrooms, sound)

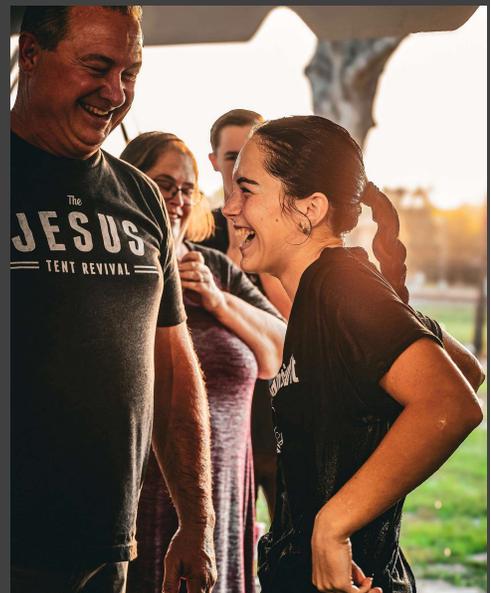


SECURITY & PARKING

Revival equipment will need to be put away nightly or have onsite (day and night) security guards. Theft and vandalism are common, if left unattended. Also, prepare for more than normal parking as guests begin to arrive.

WHY NOT ADD LOCAL CHURCH BRANDING

We have had the most success when this revival looks bigger than any one local church. This implies the event is open to all denominations to attend. It is "hosted" at your church, but not only for "your members." *Expect other churches and pastor to attend also!*

Maximize Service Effectiveness

TENT REVIVAL SERVICES CAN BE MORE THAN “REGULAR SERVICES” TAKEN OUTDOORS. CONSIDER SOME BIG CHANGES.

01 / Model Worship

Tent services are harder to “build” unless the singers & musicians on the platform are intentionally & overtly expressive. You should use only your most sincere & demonstrative “worshippers.” Make sure this team is willing to learn or pick from our list of effective songs.



02 / Service schedule & energy

We start with all of the welcomes, offerings, announcements, & introductions – then don't stop the flow thereafter. The worship team will play powerful songs that build momentum. Without interruption, preaching immediately follows.



03 / Concurrent baptisms

Often there are so many wanting to be baptized that visitors will need to be baptized during the songs, preaching, and altar service. Have the baptism team ready at all times. They do not need to interrupt the flow of the service, have microphones, or ask for permission to proceed.



04 / Encourage responding

Most evangelistic preaching will feel elementary. Encourage the church to remain excited and to affirm the Word. At the end of the service, all saints should encourage the guests to be baptized and pray for the spirit.

Small Tent Events

Here, a high volume for a low cost is critical. We forego mailers & focus efforts on door hangers in dense areas. Social media is key!

Spend Distribution:

- 50% FB & IG Video Boosting
- 30% Door Hangers & Invite Cards
- 10% Facebook Event Boosting
- 10% Yard Signs

Medium Tent Events

Some mailers can be sent to high income areas while the outreach teams do door hangers in low & medium income areas.

Spend Distribution:

- 45% FB & IG Video Boosting
- 20% Door Hangers, Cards, & Flyers
- 15% Mailers (non-profit approved)
- 15% Facebook Event Boosting
- 5% Yard Signs

Large Tent Events

At this level we can put significant investment into all forms of outreach and marketing, reaching deep into entire regions.

Tents require significant time and effort, so let's ensure the marketing budget aligns with the investment. Flyer Design

After market testing countless designs, we have collected the best flyer, door hanger, and invite cards designs. These are ready to be updated with your event dates, address, event website (we generate this), and FB event page link. Rather than gambling your budget on new designs, you can use ours!



AN OUTREACH LESSON

We should market this as an open, interdenominational event, and avoid local church branding/logos on invites. Instead, introduce logos once attendees arrive & the event starts. Why? People are drawn to an "Azusa" or "Asbury" revival in their area, and the weekend evening format works well because it doesn't compete with the services of other denominations. No labels, no tickets, no promoting preachers or churches – just Jesus. By easing concerns about denomination and dress code, we lower barriers, increase attendance, and see more conversions. Then, it's the retention material is where the local church will really put it's branding to work!



A NOTE TO MARKETING TEAM

You play an extremely vital role to maximizing the number of people that will come to this event. We highly recommend you use our proven and tested invite videos, in addition to whatever you come up with at the local church. Add anything you want to the marketing, but don't forget to upload and boost all of our required content. Our tested videos, posting schedule, and boosting guidelines are detailed in the planning website. Make sure you are registered to access those free and effective resources.



SHOW THE EXPERIENCE

The goal of media is to show the city what they will experience at the Tent. We focus content on: (1) **Baptism**, (2) Worshippers, (3) Preaching, and (4) Drone Shots – usually in that order. If they didn't attend night one, show them what they missed, & draw them to the rest of the revival! Try your hand at making videos as they work better than text or photos. Specifically: baptisms, recaps, testimony interviews, worshippers, preaching, or drone shots. Collab our personal IG & jesustentrevival pages (not FB).

Other Considerations

Let's talk through some of the miscellaneous items to be aware of. We want this event to be as successful as possible. We are determined to see a breakthrough in your region!

01

SELECTION OF LAND

You can run this at the church or off-site. Look for land that is flat and highly visible with no utilities below ground. Always check if a permit is required in your area – especially if you are off-site. Ask our evangelist what size tent they are bringing and confirm it fits on the land you have selected. Even with the best land, storms or wind could cause us to take the tent down and move the revival indoors. We've used church lawns, city ball fields, school fields, outdoor gun ranges, colleges, land from other churches, existing amphitheatres, and more

02

THE SMALL STUFF

Small details snowball into major importance. Make sure your leaders register on the detailed planning website for this info and schedule weekly leadership tag-ins. This is especially helpful in catching the small event specific details. *i.e: How do we communicate that suits aren't needed? If there are bad bugs, should we rent a bug fogger? Is it hot enough to need water bottle coolers? Is the ground well flat and well established grass? Or should we level and plant more seed? Do we need a golf cart? Do we have trash cans? Who launders towels and does overnight security?*

03

NEW RETENTION SYSTEM

We have identified best practices for retention after an event. We even built a visitor tracking and communication platform just for this event. We work together to collect registration data that's shared with the host, and used to bring them back to the local church. Retention starts with collecting the demographics from every visitor and a complete record of baptisms. To us, retention is as important as conversion! Revival in the tent can translate to lasting revival in your building!

04

FOLLOW THE PLAN

This event is not simply an indoor church service moved outside. To effectively reach the lost, many elements must be intentionally redesigned—from the service structure to every song choice. From the timing of baptisms to style of altar call, this will feel harmonious in spirit but look entirely different.

This can be one of the most effective outreach efforts you've ever run, but it is also one of the most fragile. For that reason, we ask that all of your designated leaders register for the detailed planning page and "follow the plan" closely. The pastor and his assistant/executive team should have a function knowledge of everyone's role, lead meetings, and ensure task completion.

05

EVENT SCHEDULE

Picking the event schedule is critical. We can't put a tent up with snow on the ground or tornadoes in the air. We need to schedule this event for when your evening temperatures are comfortable or even hot (since this is a night event). Pick a time with low likelihood for wind, rain, & cold. Unless you are a district, or there is a highly unusual schedule need, the revival runs Fri, Sat, and Sun nights at 7pm. We require there to be no other indoor services during the weekend; the church to fully and exclusively focus on those 3 evening services. We can add leading nights for Spanish-only revival or concurrent indoor kids crusades too!

06

DEVELOPING LEADERS

The Jesus Tent Revival needs to be focused, powerful, and intentional, but it doesn't need to be perfect. A wrong song hurts us, but a wrong note doesn't. A wrong schedule hurts us, but a late start doesn't.

If you have young people, young leaders, new altar workers, new outreach leader, or new baptizers - let's use them! It probably won't be perfect, but this is a great venue for them to get hands-on experience. You would be surprised how much value is added by their enthusiasm, passion, & expectancy. In this setting, we'd take "tears over talent!" And their gifting grows best by exposure & experience.

THE MAIN THING

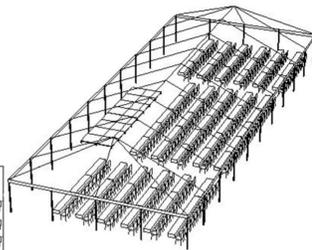
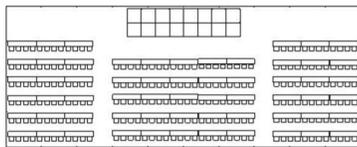
This really is a JESUS-centered event. We want an authentic, sovereign, "move of God." We want His name to be elevated. We want to see the lost born-again. We want divine signs & wonders. We want His Glory in every service. As such, we will have to genuinely explore our own hearts and readiness for this event. We each must arrive at genuine humility and hunger. To rid ourselves of any pride, division, strife, agendas, distractions, or apathy before even the first song. We need the simple desperation of Topeka, of Azusa, of Pentecost... Just a desperation for HIM and HIS MOVE!

Tent Setup & Configurations

Tents setup & take-down will take around 3-4 hrs with 25 able-bodied men (the minimum number). We have different teams & tents. Here, you can see example configurations for our small 40x100 tent

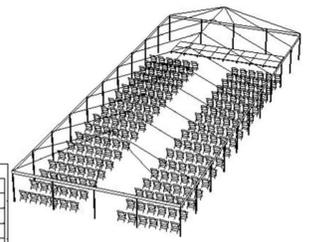
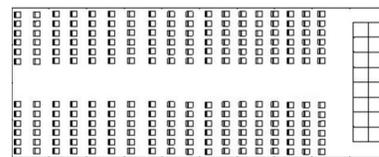
