- Home-based ketamine options for maintenance including oral Ketamine and home-based ketamine nasal sprays. Topical ketamine formulations are available for pain.
- Ketamine assisted psychotherapy. Referrals to specialty psychological counseling can be incorporated in the treatment.

- A comfortable, safe environment for each infusion.
- Medication support is available using traditional medications.
- IV Vitamin support with NAD+ therapy, High dose Vitamin C, Myer's
 Cocktails, B12, IM Vitamin D, IM CoQ10, ALA, and other
 specialty formulas as indicated. Adding Vitamin Infusions to ketamine therapy can augment outcomes.
- Cognitive assessment for brain fog and memory as related to depression.

Additional therapies for mood and depression:

- Nitrous therapies for treatment resistant depression are available.
 - Scopolamine infusions for depression/anxiety are available as an add-on option.
 - Photo biomodulation therapies with low level laser therapies for pain and depression
 - Scopolamine-beta blocker therapies for anxiety.
 - Dextromethorphan therapies for depression.

Addiction Treatment Support:


- Dr. Sendi is also Board Certified in Addiction Medicine.
- Suboxone/Zubsolv/Buprenorphine/Sublocade support for opiate addiction.
- Ketamine therapies for PAWS (Post-Acute Withdrawal Syndrome)
- Vivitrol therapies opiate blocking, monthly injections of Naltrexone

We offer Alcohol Treatment with FDA approved and alternative therapies, including Ketamine therapies: Youtube Videos regarding :alcoholism and ketamine.

Obesity Medical Management:

- Dr. Sendi is also Board Certified in Obesity Medicine and can evaluate and treat clients for obesity and any nutritional deficiencies.
- We can evaluate individuals for fat and muscle mass as well as resting metabolic rate using a KORR calorimeter and SECA scale for four-compartment modeling during a weight loss journey.
- Obesity and nutritional depletion are associated with depression, aging, and metabolic disorders. Dr. Sendi offers FDA approved and off-label medications for weight loss and sarcopenia.

- IM MIC injections for weight loss are available.
- Medical meal replacements for weight loss are available and can be utilized through the Optifast and Virtual Health platforms.
- Nutritionist support is available through the Optifast and virtual health platforms.



Ketamine Infusions are performed in a calming, comfortable, immersive environment with ambient music and aromatherapy at NOVA Health Recovery.

We have rapidly available appointments with evening hours and direct access to Dr. Sendi by cell phone. We use the OSMIND mood app, which tracks and monitors depression and anxiety to follow each of our patients.

Cost of Treatment:


Ketamine HC

- \$350 for the consultation.
- \$480 per infusion. Generally, 6 infusions are needed for depression, PTSD, and anxiety over two weeks. Payment is at each visit. We accept CareCredit, which offers interest-free financing for 12 months.
- Booster infusions are usually monthly and cost \$480. We prescribe the next month of home ketamine therapy at that appointment. We can manage your regular medications as well at these appointments.
- Home-based ketamine therapy is prescribed after the initial infusion series and costs about \$110/month from the compounding pharmacies.
- We do not accept insurance. Insurance does not cover this treatment, but we can provide superbills (with procedure codes) for you to submit to your insurance for out of network expenses.
- We offer evening appointments. You should be fine to work the next day after your infusion.

How Long Should You Expect to have Ketamine Therapies?

- After the initial 6 infusions, most will return at 2 weeks for a booster infusion and then at 4 weeks.
- This therapy is a treatment, not a cure, but may make allow your mood to improve rapidly and your underlying medications work better. Some will titrate off medications that have excessive side-effects.
- Each person is different, and some may receive therapies for several months and then be fine. Others will maintain their therapy with home-based ketamine options, needing only a consultation for the next prescription.
- Lifestyle changes and interventions are also discussed so you can optimize your results.
