Hello Dental Professionals!

The Manitoba Dental Association (MDA) is partnering with Manitoba Dental Assistants Association (MDAA), Manitoba Dental Hygienists Association (MDHA) and Canadian Blood Services (CBS) for a fun opportunity to give back to Manitobans. This October 2025, we are asking you to go the extra mile by participating in a province-wide blood donation challenge.

When your team donates together, the impact goes beyond saving lives:

- You build stronger workplace bonds & foster a culture of purpose & compassion
- · You give back to your community in the most meaningful way

More patients need blood products than CBS has seen over the past decade. Only 2% of Canadians donate and their donations supply the ENTIRE country. We can't continue to rely on this small group to support Canada's growing and aging population – that's why we are asking for your help. Every month in Manitoba there are 5,000 appointments that must be filled. Donated blood lasts only 42 days, with the majority used the first 5 days.

Participating in the October Blood Donation Challenge is very easy... and there's a chance to win a pizza party!

I can't donate blood. How do I participate?

Our eligibility is changing all the time!
I would suggest double-checking your eligibility
by completing our Eligibility Quiz at
https://myaccount.blood.ca/en/eligibility-quiz

If you've confirmed you aren't eligible, ask a family or friend to donate on your behalf. If they have joined the team, they will count towards your team goal – just let your Team Champion know the name of the person subbing in for when the final tallies are complete.

Our office isn't in Winnipeg – how can we get involved?

Our team is out several times a week with mobile clinics all over Manitoba! Check your postal code at <u>blood.ca</u> to see if an upcoming mobile is near you. Otherwise, you're always welcome to book an appointment the next time you are in the city or any one of the communities we visit.

You also have the option to ask someone to substitute in for you who happens to be in Winnipeg or another community we visit. Just let your Team Champion know the name of the person subbing in for when the final tallies are complete.

Finally, our Stem Cell Swab kits are portable! Just send an email to lisa.beechinor@blood.ca and we'll bring or send the kits to you for completion.

We have a big office - could you come to us?

Our mobile clinics are planned approximately two years in advance and require an extensive amount of logistical review and support, so we do not have the capacity to provide private blood donation clinics to individual businesses. However, we have a shuttle bus that flts up to 14 people on it and are happy to arrange a pickup from your location to ours for a team donation. To arrange a shuttle bus appointment, email me at lisa.beechinor@blood.ca with your preferred date and time and we'll make the arrangements!

How do I book /reserve group appointments?

I can help with that! Please email <u>lisa.beechinor@blood.ca</u> to inquire about reserving appointments and transportation.

Our system will release any unfilled appointments 7 days prior to donation date so you don't need to monitor.

We want to hear from you! The MDAA is currently collecting wage and workplace data from dental assistants across Manitoba — and your participation is incredibly valuable.





Your input matters. The more responses we receive, the stronger our case will be when speaking up for dental assistants like you.





