## The Office of Professional Standards investigates complaints

- From people with firsthand knowledge of an incident that occurred in the last 180 days
- Made by parents or legal guardians on behalf of minors or dependent adults
- From anonymous sources alleging serious violations (at the discretion of the Office of Professional Standards (OPS) Commander, the appropriate Bureau Chief, the Chief of Police, or designee)

*Unless approved by the OPS Commander, Bureau Chief, Chief of Police, or designee, the following are not accepted:*

- Anonymous complaints alleging minor violations
- Complaints alleging minor violations where the incident occurred more than 180 days ago

## Arizona state law requires the following notice:

Pursuant to section 13-2907.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, it is a class 1 misdemeanor to knowingly make to a law enforcement agency a false, fraudulent or unfounded report or statement or to knowingly misrepresent a fact for the purpose of interfering with the orderly operation of a law enforcement agency or misleading a peace officer.

Captain John Carlson

**Complaint\***

Off Duty TPD Captain John Carlson came into Charro Steak with a group of other individuals looking to have dinner Saturday night. Upon entering, CPT Carlson and other members of his party appeared to have possibly already had a drink or two. While waiting for other members of their party to arrive, CPT Carlson and other members of his party began order drinks from the bar. Once they were seated, Charro Steak [REDACTED] Sean [REDACTED] began taking orders, before doing so, he asked the party if anyone was driving. This questions upset a member of CPT Carlson's party, and they refused to answer in a manner that would assure Sean no one was driving. Sean then made the decision not to serve the party any more drinks. It is because of this, Carlson and others attempted to order drinks from the bar again, where both the [REDACTED] (Aura [REDACTED]) and the [REDACTED] (Sal [REDACTED]) informed him that him and his party would not be served anymore drinks. After hearing this, Captain Carlson and others of his party began shouting obscenities at the bartender, the manager, and their server, in the middle of the restaurant. While shouting obscenities, they also made crude gestures, and Captain Carlson made a generic claim that he was a part of TPD and that they knew they were being responsible. The party then left the restaurant and abandoned a bill that was over \$300. This was the last interaction anyone had with Captain Carlson.
