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I believe that based on my experience, training, and investigation that the facts establishing
probable cause for the issuance of this search warrant for the foregoing described property,
person(s), or the foregoing location are as follows:

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As set forth in this affidavit, that I, Detective V. Duarte, your affiant, am a Peace Officer in
the State of Arizona, employed by the Pima County Sheriff's Department. I have been a
police officer for 6 years and I am currently assigned as a Detective in the Domestic
Violence Unit. My training and experience includes Completing the Pima County Sheriff's
Department Basic Law Enforcement Academy. I have also completed the 12 week post
basic program. As well as 12 week Field Training Program. I have attended various
training schools and in service training in my profession sponsored by the Pima County
Sheriff's Department and Arizona Police Officer's Standardized Training. I have
investigated numerous cases in my capacity and have prepared and obtained several search
warrants.

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Your affiant states that the investigation is being conducted by the Pima County Sheriff's Department.
Your affiant is familiar with the facts and circumstances of this investigation. Such familiarity having
been gained through your affiant's personal knowledge based upon participation of this investigation,
statements made to your affiant by other detectives, review of records and documents. Based upon all
of the foregoing your affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that:

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On July 20th at approximately 0000 hours Krishna Millhoff stated she was assaulted
within the area of Speedway and Silverbell in Tucson Arizona. In the morning she
responded to Marana Hospital due to the injuries she sustained. She advised Law
Enforcement that this was a "Family matter" when questioned she stated that her wife
Alisa Cunningham was the only family she has in town. It is believed that Krishna and
Alisa may have been in a Domestic Violence incident. Upon my arrival to Krishna and
Alisa's residence I spoke with Krishna who stated that Alisa was out of state. It was
discovered that Alisa is out of state however has the weekend to do as she pleases. Alisa was
contacted and stated she is aware of this incident. She provided me with a contact to
confirm she was out of state the entire time, however during questioning the individual
could only verify that she attended the training during the allotted training hours, not what

1 she was doing on the weekend. Due to both parties being uncooperative it is believed that
2 they may be in contact with each other. Once served, this warrant will show if Alisa was in
3 Tucson during the time of the assault or if she was out of state as she claims.

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5 Based on the above facts your affiant requests that a search warrant be issued with respect
6 to the above described person(s), premises, or thing(s).
