Investigative Summary

Synopsis:

On 4/4/2025, Sgt. Pelton was asked to review BWC involving Ofc. Voss from an incident that occurred on 1/16/2025. The review of BWC was a result of a Use of Force by Officer Voss under the same incident that occurred on 1/29/2025. After the review of BWC footage, there were several statements made by Ofc. Voss to a citizen that raised concerns of unprofessionalism and rudeness.

Investigative Steps:

AA 104335 3/4/2025

I received a call from LT Bredehoft requesting an OPS case # for Ofc. Voss #43601 for the allegations of 304-Rudeness and 306-Unprofessionalism.

AA 104335 6/25/2025

I received a copy of the Attachment A draft from LT Bredehoft.

AA 104335 7/2/2025

I received the completed investigation from the ODE Chain of Command. The findings for the allegations were **SUSTAINED** and the chain recommended a **10-HR SUSPENSION** for a **Yellow-Level** violation.

None of the ORs done by the chain of command, nor the Attachment A mentioned the allegation of **304-Rudeness**, therefore it was removed from the case.

I had already received a copy of the Attachment A draft from Lt. Bredehoft. I requested and received the PARF from HR. I sent a copy of the investigation, the PARF, and the Attachment A to City Attorney Jennifer Stash.

AA 104335 7/7/2025

I received the approval for the Attachment A from Jennifer Stash, with a signed copy of the PARF on 7/4/25. I took the PARF and copies of the investigation for Chief's signature.

AA 104335 7/07/2025

I sent the Service Memo, Member Disclosure, 7-Day Notice, Like Cases, Attachment A, and the PARF to the chain for service. I gave Axon Access to all members that took part in the investigation.

AA 104335 7/15/2025

I received notice from Ofc. Voss that he would like a grievance panel. I suspended the case until the grievance is done.

AA 104335 7/17/2025

I received all the signed service paperwork. Copies were sent to HR.

AA 104335 12/23/2025

I received notice from Ofc. Voss that he would like to cancel his grievance with the Chief. I closed the case with a sustained finding and a Yellow-10 Hour Suspension. No further action was taken.

Conclusion:

The investigation concludes that the allegations of **306- Unprofessionalism** and **304- Rudeness** are **SUSTAINED** and that Ofc. Voss #43601 violated the following Tucson Police General Orders: 1330.2 Obedience to General Orders, Procedures and Policies Required, 1330.7 General Standards of Expected Conduct, 1330.8 Expected Conduct Towards the Public, and 1330.11 Compliance with Code of Ethics and Department Values Required. The violations of these General Orders fall within the **Yellow** range in the Discipline Thermometer and the chain concurred with a recommendation of a **10-HR SUSPENSION**. This case is now closed.
