# Explore Outdoors

Calhoun County boasts an astounding array of outdoor recreational opportunities. From kayaking, horseback riding and fishing to mountain biking and hiking, Calhoun County can provide you with an ideal itinerary for an outdoor enthusiast!

Camp McClellan Horse Trails

Mud Hole Rd. off of Iron Mountain Rd. 256-589-9443 Camp McClellan is a 900-acre equestrian campground on the historic former Ft. McClellan Military Base with over 28 miles of well-marked trails, formed by a partnership with the Calhoun County Commission and the McClellan Chapter of Back Country Horsemen of America (BCHA).

### Cheaha State Park

19644 Hwy. 281, Delta, 256-488-5111

Just twenty miles from Anniston, Cheaha State Park, is the highest point of Alabama. The state's first State Park is a haven for outdoor enthusiasts or those just wanting to catch a breathtaking sunset. With its hiking and mountain biking trails, and swimming options, the park has it all, including meeting/wedding venue space, restaurant, lodging and camping accommodations.

### Chief Ladiga Trail

Anniston/Weaver/Jacksonville/Piedmont

The Chief Ladiga Trail currently runs 32.5 miles from the Alabama/Georgia line into the City of Anniston. As Alabama's first Rails to Trails project, this paved recreational trail follows the former Seaboard/CSX Railroad and connects to Georgia's 63 mile Silver

Comet Trail, making Ladiga part of the longest paved rail trail in the U.S. for walkers, runners, cyclists, skaters, or strollers.

Choccolocco Creek Archealogical Complex The Alabama Indigenous Mound Trail at Choccolocco Park informs visitors of the rich, indigenous cultures that populated Alabama for thousands of years, predating statehood through an historic interpretive trail with signage.

This Off-Road Vehicle Park welcomes every type of off-road vehicle, including ATV's, side-by-sides, dirt bikes, four wheel drives, rail buggies, and rock crawlers. This 450 acre of forest covered mountains has a vast trail system, with moderate to extreme trails for more advanced vehicles.

### Choccolocco Park

This sports and recreation venue hosts athletic events and features baseball/softball, track and soccer fields, a an 18-hole disc golf course, picnic pavilions, walking and biking trails, and a fully accessible Boundless Playground.

This more than 500 acre public facility offers sport shooters opportunities to practice and participate in competitive events, with state of the art electronic targets and monitors for participants and spectators.

### Coldwater Mountain Bike Trail Off Hwy 202, Anniston

Located on 4,000 acres of Coldwater Mountain in Anniston, this world class trail offers both 1.5 mile beginner loops, for riders of any level, and a 10 mile Blue Loop for intermediate riders. Currently, more than 35 miles of singletrack trails have been built under the supervision of IMBA Trail Solutions. Two locations are available for access to the trails. The Coldwater Trailhead is located at 1661 Coldwater Road in Anniston, while the Anniston Trailhead



is located at 401 Monsanto Street in Anniston. For more information, visit www.neaba.net.

Henry Farm Mountain Bike & Running Trails 351 Henry Road, Jacksonville

Located on the mountain adjacent to the Henry Farm Baseball Fields and parking lot, these trails are great for beginners and experienced riders and runners, with rock features and gradual climbs. The four loop trails are also open to pedestrians. The park also contains the Kiwanis Walking Trail and multiple nature trails which are open to foot traffic only.

Indian Mountain ATV Park

Little River Canyon

### McClellan Bike Trails

Located on the former Ft. McClellan army installation, McClellan Moutain Bike Trails consist of 10 miles of purpose built singletrack and is perfect for beginner riders of all ages. It is the first specifically designed NICA trail in the state of Alabama. The system has a great variety of green and blue trail segments. Trail names capture the history of the military base, community figures and local heroes.

### Mountain Longleaf National Wildlife Refuge

Bains Gap Road, Anniston

With more than 6,000 acres, this area was designated as a National Wildlife Refuge to protect a unique and endangered ecosystem, the mountain longleaf pine forest. This land is also home to the Bain's Gap Waterfall and trails.

### Neely Henry Lake

Ohafchee

This 11,000 acre lake is perfect for skiing, boating and fishing along Hwy 77 North. This area has public boat launches, picnic areas and fishing piers perfect for the whole family.

# Oxford Lake and Coldwater Covered Bridge 401 McCullars Lane, Oxford, 256-831-2660

Stretch your legs on this paved and gravel track around the lake or spread out a picnic for the whole family, while the kids play on the adventure park playground. This area also houses tennis courts, a swimming pool, baseball complex, indoor basketball courts, a newly renovated and expanded civic center space and more. It is also home to one of Alabama's oldest remaining covered bridges, moved from Coldwater Creek to Oxford Lake and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

### Pinhoti National Recreation Trail

Talladega/Cleburne/Calhoun Counties

This is Alabama's premiere long-distance recreation trail, spanning 110 miles through the state and traversing the ridges and crests of the Talladega National Forest Mountains continuing in Georgia for a total of 335 miles to connect with the Appalachian Trail.



### Centennial Memorial Park

225 E. 17th Street, Anniston

Since 1999, this site serves as the official home of Alabama's Veterans Memorial and State Enforcement Memorial. The names of every Alabamian killed during World War I, World War II, the Korean War, Vietnam, Persian Gulf, and officers killed in the line of duty are engraved on the granite wall. Resolutions have been passed to add Afghanistan and Iraq as well as Firefighters.

### Freedom Riders National Monument 1031 Gurnee Avenue, Anniston

National Park Service opened this monument in January 2017 and it is comprised of two areas. Visitors can view a bus mural at the site of the former Greyhound bus station. Interpretive panels as well as a solar audio post recap the events of 1961, depicting the history of Calhoun County during the Civil Rights movement. The second location is the site where segregationists attacked and burned the bus six miles down the road adjacent to State Route 202.

### Cobb High Sports Museum

Built in 1863 & 1864 to produce pig iron during the Civil War, this site and surrounding park hosts the Reenactment of the Battle of Ten Islands each spring. Their Museum houses Native American artifacts and memorabilia from the Civil War.


