

Students send their photos and letters to the Moon through the Blatantly Honest Foundation

The first launch into space is planned to take off in the fourth quarter of 2020. Then in 2022, the rocket will launch a microchip with thousands of memories, photos and personal letters to permanently reside on the moon

The Pledge Against Bullying is a program adopted by the Blatantly Honest Foundation. The program, established by David Van De Velde, Founder of Ketel One Vodka and Van Gogh Vodka, works to educate students on bullying and how important self-confidence is to growing teens. Van De Velde partnered with Makaila Nichols, founder of the foundation, to produce effective school curriculums to change the culture of schools.
