OUR STORY

Makaila Nichols was bullied unmercifully throughout her adolescence and even today as a college student. She found that through writing she was able to cope with the struggles she was enduring. Makaila decided to turn her story into a book that could be used as an aid for other teens experiencing similar issues. Makaila then wrote: "Blatantly Honest: Normal Teen, Abnormal Life" which became a best-seller in two categories: "Parenting of Teens" and "Teen Social Issues." This propelled Makaila into speaking engagements across the county for elementary, middle, high school and other organizations. As Makaila continued to share her story, it spread across different avenues, one of which is coloring books. Now, elementary aged students can learn real life situations about bullying and body image inside the classroom to be followed up with a speech from Makaila for maximum impact. The Blatantly Honest ® Foundation was created to ensure that students everywhere have access to books, speaking engagements and other educational resources to combat social issues in the youth.



CURRICULUM PROGRAMS

Art Meets Bullying

Students are able to express how bullying makes them feel through various forms of art.

Bullying Hurts

Each student receives a First Aid Kit, 3 bandages, anti-bacteria ointment, an alcohol pad and a sticker reminding them that Bullying Hurts.

Coloring Books

For elementary school students only. Students are able to read, color and follow a story about anti-bullying and inclusion in both English and Spanish.

Dodge a Bully

Each student will be able to take part in various obstacle courses which encourages students to work together as a team.

Essay Program

Students are asked to write a short essay about bullying or other prompts.

Makaila Nichols - Speech

Makaila Nichols will give a school wide assembly discussing her own experiences with bullying and other teenage dilemmas.

Moon Mission

Students are able to send their personal items into space and onto the moon via Celestis Inc. partnership. We encourage students to learn just how incredible this opportunity is by diving into space education.

The Celestis contract contains a performance guarantee offering a complimentary second mission should the first mission attempt fail to achieve success.

Sunflower Seed Planting

Students will come together to plant sunflowers or other types of flowers at the school. The students are asked to nurture and take care of these followers as they symbolically represent a field of kindness.

United Nation's Day

As proclaimed by the United Nations, we have secured a national anti-bullying day. Students are encouraged to learn about the United Nations and how important their voices are.

Walk-a-Mile in My Shoes

Fundraising opportunity for students to walk-a-mile and raise money for the school. Students are encouraged to walk the mile with someone they do not know well and learn more about that individual.

AWARENESS PROGRAMS

Banner Pledge

Students will sign a banner to show their commitment to upholding the pledge against bullying oath. They can sign the custom-made banner during lunch hours, and it is encouraged that it's flown somewhere on school property to remind students daily.

Greetings from the Moon

One of our programs allows students to go to the moon and into space via MicroSDcard. For holidays, we would welcome additional photos, messages or voice recordings from students and their families. This is another fundraising opportunity for the school and the program.

Holiday Program

Buttons and Stickers for the Holidays (Valentine's Day, Fourth of July, etc.)

Homecoming Program

School wide dress down to promote the school colors and unity.

Mean Girl's Day

School wide dress down to promote "You can sit with us," Encourage students to sit with someone new and promote random acts of kindness.

No Clowning Around

Red Nose Day at school, students will sign a banner during lunch and they will receive a Red Nose to increase awareness against bullying.

Stomp Out Bullying

Students use chalk to draw positive messages on the sidewalk, write how bullying has affected them, or what bullying they wish to stomp out.
