## *A Message from Pastor Jaime*

*Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I will say, Rejoice. Let your gentleness be known to everyone. The Lord is near. Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. - Philippians 4:4-7*

This is such a familiar passage to me. Maybe it is to you, too. I remember hearing those words about the peace that passes understanding sometimes at the end of sermons. I remember singing in the children's choir about having "the peace that passes understanding down in my heart to stay." And I'm sure I have seen the words "rejoice in the Lord always" on a pillow or a poster somewhere along the line.

God brought this passage to my mind again a couple weeks ago when I was feeling a little worried. I don't even remember now what I was worrying about, but I heard these words of scripture about worry, and God reminded me to respond with prayer.

So often my initial reaction is to sit and stew in my worry, to try to plot out my options to resolve whatever is troubling me. But God reminds me that I don't have to handle my worries alone. I can bring them straight to God, who wants me to know peace. And that is reason to give thanks!

We as the church have experienced worry and distress, too, especially in these past few years. Worship attendance had already dropped for many congregations, and then a pandemic dramatically changed how we worship. We've worried about who would come back - and who wouldn't. We've maybe worried about transitions in leadership. We've worried about divisions in our society and congregations.
