# A Message from Pastor Jaime

In the month of September, we heard Jesus say a LOT about wealth.

For example, on September 7, we heard him say, "None of you can become my disciple if you do not give up all your possessions."

And on the 21st: "You cannot serve God and wealth."

Then we heard a story about a rich man who ignored his poor neighbor, Lazarus.

We might not like to talk about money – at least not in church – but Jesus does not seem to have that same hang-up.

And if we are willing to listen, we will discover that Jesus isn't necessarily saying that wealth is bad (though he certainly acknowledges that wealth is often accumulated by dishonest means). Jesus teaches us what to do with our wealth, whether that wealth is great or small.

Jesus teaches us to be good stewards of all that God has given us, not just monetary wealth, but also gifts like our attention, our health, our voices, our time, and our relationships.

Over the next several weeks we will practice broadening our perspectives on stewardship. Yes, we'll continue to hear Jesus say some things directly related to money. But we'll also hear Jesus teach us to use our whole lives in service to God and our neighbors.

That is stewardship!

Our lives, and all that we have, are gifts from our lavishly generous God. We give of our time, our talents, our possessions, and – yes – our money in response to God's generosity toward us.

In light of God's love, goodness, mercy, and generosity, how are we called to live, as individuals and as a congregation? That is a stewardship question – and therefore a discipleship question. We'll explore that question together this fall in worship.
