## A Message from Pastor Jaime

But wait - there's more!

As you may already know, our Greater Milwaukee Synod Assembly took place on May 20 and 21, and the Rev. Paul Erickson was re-elected as our synod bishop.

But that's not all that happened! Gathered in person and online under the theme of We Love All: Creating Communities of Welcome, we worshiped together, took time for Bible study, and heard updates from ministries across our synod and the wider church.

I want to share two experiences that I will continue to think and pray about in the coming days and weeks.

In worship, we heard a powerful message from Pastor Marilyn Miller. She preached on John 5:1-9, the story of Jesus healing a man who had been ill for 38 years. Jesus asks him: "Do you want to be made well?" And Jesus tells him, "Stand up, take your mat and walk." Pastor Marilyn asked us to consider the ways the church needs to be healed, especially from "isms" such as racism, ageism, and heterosexism - and whether we are willing to leave the familiarity of our own mats in order to be made well. She asked: "Church, do you want to be made well?"

We were also led in Bible study by Pastors Bill Beyer and Char Guiliani, leaders of our synod's Reconciling in Christ Ministry Team. We spent time in John 11:28-44, in which Jesus raises his friend Lazarus. At the tomb, Jesus calls to Lazarus, "Come out!" When Lazarus comes out, bound in strips of cloth, Jesus
