Pre-Entries open on March 22, 2021 and must be postmarked no later than April 26, 2021.

Please use the Official ASCA Entry Forms. Those may be found at www.asca.org. Please be certain you are using the most up to date forms. There will be a \$35.00 service charge for any returned checks. Refunds issued up to pre-entry deadline. No refunds after that date. Substitutions allowed with dogs that you own or co-own. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

PRE-ENTRY PROCEDURE:

Entries open with postmarks of March 22 or later. We will accept a combined total of 60 runs per day, meaning the total number of entries for Obedience and Rally will not exceed 60 runs. If we fill prior to the pre-entry deadline, we will announce we are full and will then begin a wait list. If anyone tells me they are not coming, we will work our way down the list to fill those spots. All entrants will receive an email letting them know the status of their entries, whether entered or wait-listed. Entries close with postmarks of April 26. Any entry received with a postmark after April 26 will be returned.

AWARDS:

Class placements, Q ribbons and new title ribbons will be flats. Rosettes will be awarded for HIT awards. There may be special sponsored awards, please make sure to sign up if offered. Ribbons and placements will be issued at the completion of each class. Ribbons will not be awarded in the Ring but awarded outside in a self-serve manner. Judge's books will be posted for each competitor to review their scores. HIT ribbons will be given out at the end of each trial.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and Regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- ASCA has the right to reprimand or suspend any person or persons from any or all privileges of ASCA for conduct prejudicial to the best interests of the Australian Shepherd, ASCA events or ASCA. Exhibitors are to maintain the highest level of sportsmanship and are to conduct themselves accordingly. Foul or abusive language, yelling at exhibitors or judges, disorderly conduct, and/or poor sportsmanship will not be allowed and shall be disciplined in accordance with Chapter 11 and the ASCA Dispute Rules and ASCA Discipline Guidelines.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- GAASC will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made. No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disobedience, fire and act of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, COVID or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- GAASC requires that you pick up after your dog at the show site and the hotel. Any complaints made by the hotel could result in loss of future trial privileges. All dogs must be on lead. No parking in fire lanes.

Covid-19 related information: The show ring is indoors, in a climate controlled building.

- When in the building, masks will be required at ALL times, including while showing in the ring. Please bring masks with you along with hand sanitizer.
- The 6 foot social distancing rule be maintained at all times.
- Bathroom facilities are available; please remember to maintain the 6 foot rule while waiting.
- ASCA has mandated that the immediate show area be restricted to exhibitors, judges, committee, and club volunteers. Limited crating will be available near the show ring but must be 6 feet apart per handler.
- Armbands and rubber bands will be dispensed to you; no self-serve. Your cooperation is appreciated.
- The show committee has the right to ask any person to leave the show area.
- Competitors will be required to remain outside until they are the team "on deck" to go into the ring. We will allow you and your dog into the building at that time to warm up.
- We will have a Door Steward monitoring the comings and goings of people in and out of the building. We want to limit the number of people in the building at any given time.

- Dog crating will be allowed in the building. We will have a “Move In” time each morning. Only one person will be allowed in the building at a time, to set up their crate/s and settle their dog/s. No other equipment than the crate, leash and water bowl will be allowed to be left in the building. We will also request that crating areas for each competitor be 6’ away from another competitor’s crating area, whenever possible.
- Crates set up in the building may be left overnight.

REGULATORY Class MODIFICATIONS:

Figure 8 exercise: Cones will be used as posts.

Novice Group exercise: Dogs & handlers will be placed safely apart for Covid19 rules.

Exhibitors will be the only ones handling their leashes and dumbbells.

Stewards will use gloves or tongs to handle utility articles and gloves.
