#### Showgrounds open at 1 pm on Friday and 7 a.m. Saturday and Sunday We have to wait for the Farm Trial to clear the "Conformation Pasture" before we set up. Please wait at the truck stops/restaurants close to Hardrock Farm before 1 pm. We cannot allow any congestion on the road or driveway.

Showing, grooming and crating outdoors, electricity for grooming is not provided. Please consider bringing canopies/shade for you and your dogs. Generators welcome at your grooming site. There is no overnight camping on the show grounds.

This is a working farm, so please be mindful of cleaning up after your dog where appropriate and please respect the livestock and competitors trialing their dogs.

Please maintain distance and sight lines that will not disrupt their runs.

#### <u>Awards</u>

**Conformation:** Ribbons awarded for 1st through 4th place, with large rosettes for premium awards. Dog related prizes for premium awards may also be available. Class or Show sponsorships are available. Please contact the show secretary for more information. **Sponsors are appreciated at ALL GAASC events** 

**Suzanne Kinman Award:** Each year at Spring Fling we honour the memory of a great friend to GAASC, Judge Suzanne Kinman. She always supported the club by judging for us and was a believer in the versatility of our breed. This award will be presented at the end of the weekend to the Australian Shepherd who was shown in at least one regular Conformation class and had the highest score from any one of the arena trials. In the event of a tie, it will be broken by the dog's highest cattle score.

**Southeast Champion Stampede**: This show is the second in a cluster of three consecutive weekends of ASCA Conformation showing for the Southeast Champion Stampede. In order to compete for the prizes, your dog must be entered in each of the clubs shows, but not necessarily every show for each weekend cluster. The clubs are Carolina Australian Shepherd Club (CASC), Greater Atlanta Australian Shepherd Club (GAASC), & Tidewater Australian Shepherd Club (TASC). #### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and Regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- ASCA has the right to reprimand or suspend any person or persons from any or all privileges of ASCA for conduct prejudicial to the best interests of the Australian Shepherd, ASCA events or ASCA. Exhibitors are to maintain the highest level of sportsmanship and are to conduct themselves accordingly. Foul or abusive language, yelling at exhibitors or judges, disorderly conduct, and/or poor sportsmanship will not be allowed and shall be disciplined in accordance with Chapter 11 and the ASCA Dispute Rules and ASCA Discipline Guidelines.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- GAASC will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made. No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disobedience, fire and act of God, public emergency, and act of a public enemy, COVID or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- GAASC requires that you pick up after your dog at the show site and the hotel. Any complaints made by the hotel could result in loss of future trial privileges. All dogs must be on lead. No parking in fire lanes.

Covid-19 related information: The show ring is outside.

- Masks are required in and around the show ring; at your set-up, you may choose not to wear a mask. Please bring masks with you as well as with hand sanitizer.
- The 6 foot social distancing rule be maintained at all times, which includes grooming tables, crating, etc. Porta potties will be on site.
- ASCA has mandated that the immediate show area be restricted to exhibitors, judges, committee, and club volunteers. Limited crating will be available near the show ring but must be 6 feet apart per handler.
- In order to reduce exposure of the show volunteers, stewards, etc., in handling paperwork and money, we recommend that you Pre-enter as opposed to a Day-Of-Show entry. Completing entries at the Secretary/Stewart/Judges' tables is prohibited. Please bring your completed Day-Of entry to the desk with correct payment attached. Use of checks rather than cash is recommended.
- Armbands and rubber bands will be dispensed to you; no self-serve. Your cooperation is appreciated.
- The show committee has the right to ask any person to leave the show area.
