

The summary of my hypotheses

They are at the core of my work and writing and which produced the documentation that supports them. My book debates these hypotheses and provides the needed documentation.

The first hypothesis was about the effect produced by the Geomagnetic Excursions that generates increased over baseline of the atmospheric amount of C14 isotopes. It was hard to achieve documentation that supports this hypothesis.

Further work found that several other cosmogenic factors generate a similar effect of C14 atmospheric increase.

Analyzing the brain work from the point of view of its energetic consumption I found (the second hypothesis) that the human brain maneuvers the linear and nonlinear processes to adapt and adjust to changes in its energetic consumption.

The third hypothesis, summating the previous two hypotheses, refers to the fact that all changes, ultimately, represent changes in brain consumption.

And then, the mentioned change between linear and nonlinear predominance in mental processing generated the fourth hypothesis that human behavior reflects the mentioned predominance, as the way the brain processes, causes pulses of Neurogenesis which are responsible to assist the cognition.

Thus, **the fourth hypothesis** found and demonstrated to my best that in the last 70,000 years the human brain had several cognition changes, which I called the Cognitive Revolutions and which after 1950 became a chain of Technological Revolutions.

I identified the **First Cognitive Revolutio**n as bringing in the predominance of a nonlinear mental processing that archaeologically is unveiled to occur between 70,000 to 30,000 years ago.

The **Second Cognitive Revolution** occurred between 30,000 to 13,000 years ago and consolidated the Matriarchate. The most important change was the increased adoption of acoustic signal processing generating the change from a "static" to a "dynamic" language. The language became the most significant "tool" that is considered highly influential in "linear thinking," in development of consciousness, but also as the head-designer for all technologies which humanity created.

The **Third Cognitive Revolution** occurred 13,000-5,000 years ago and gradually developed the Hybrid State of the Mind as a combination of nonlinear and linear modalities inside the neuronal- tract system that transports visual and acoustic signals. It started with plant and animal domestication and gradually evolved to the Megalithic Culture.

The Fourth Cognitive Revolution started 5,000 years ago and it is still active today. This revolution created our "material civilization."

Within this revolution occurred some other smatter revolutions, like those from the 2500 years ago, which produced the "linear analytic thinking (or the philosophy the mathematics) of the Greek Antiquity, produced the Hellenistic Culture, and in opposition to this, it created in Asia the Taoist, Buddhist and Zen philosophies, and consolidated the incipient Hinduism.

Much later, the chain of Solar Minima from 1500 AD to 1850 AD. It generated a corresponding chain of revolutions in finances, banking, science and caused the Industrial Revolution.

Further on, after 1950, the doubling of the C14 atmospheric concentration, as a result of the atmospheric experiments with Atomic Bombs, stimulated pulses of neurogenesis responsible for the Technological Revolutions, which continue today.

Up to this point, I have shown four major cognitive revolutions with other embedded somehow smaller revolutions or sub-revolutions.

My **Fifth Hypothesis** is about the diminishing of the speed of human mental processing that makes the neuronal circuits process all information produced by our senses in much more detail than the monkey's brain can analyze. This is called "functional mental processing latency," and probably is at the foundation of a mental process that allowed us to produce almost all the "discoveries."
