In 1997, Ravi joined forces with like-minded Long Beach and San Diego based artists to form the esoteric spaceklezmer band, the Rabbinical School Dropouts. Led by brothers Michael and Jonathan Friedmann, RSDO performed in a variety of styles drawing largely from experimental jazz, Afro-Cuban, Levantine, and Balkan musical forms. ### BIOGRAPHY

Ravi Deo is a musician, ethnomusicologist, and multidisciplinary creative artist dedicated to bridging generations and communities through performing arts. A foremost artist of the Pt. Bansilalji lineage, he has performed as a tabla soloist and accompanist across the U.S. and abroad.

His compositions span film, TV, theater, dance, and video game, and he has performed with the Pacific Symphony Orchestra. Deo also co-founded the klezmer band Rabbinical School Dropouts, touring nationally and releasing music on John Zorn's Tzadik label.

He is completing a Masters in Fine Arts at the California Institute of the Arts in Performance and Composition, focusing on improvisation, Hindustani music, and Indonesian performance. His studies at CalArts are generously supported by the Dr Rajeev Taranath Award, Remo Percussion Scholarship, and HASOM Dean's Grant.

Passionate about community building, Ravi approaches Hindustani music as a living tradition, fostering connections between emerging and established artists across disciplines.
