Teens offer free 1:1 tech help to kūpuna—in person and online—earning \$50 stipends to support their service.

Certifications for Teens

After 30+ volunteer hours, teens earn IC3, Microsoft, or cybersecurity certifications—opening doors to future jobs and internships.

Our 2025 Goal – \$75,000

Help us fund:

- \$25,000 – Youth stipends
- \$16,000 – Teen certifications
- \$10,000 – Devices for kūpuna
- \$5,000 – Outreach & workshops
- \$4,000 – AI Help Desk + program tools
- \$15,000 – Expansion and capacity
