## Certifications for Teens

After 30+ volunteer hours, teens earn IC3, Microsoft, or cybersecurity certifications—opening doors to future jobs and internships.

## Our 2026 Goal – \$50,000

## **A LETTER FROM OUR FOUNDER**

May 7, 2026

Aloha Friends & Supporters,

I started Tech Savvy Teens because I believed two things deeply: that Hawaii's young people have more to offer than anyone is asking of them — and that our kūpuna deserve better than being left behind in a world that has gone digital without them.

What I didn't expect was how powerful it would be to watch those two truths meet in the same room.

When one of our students sits down with a kūpuna at a senior center and helps them video call a grandchild for the first time, or walk through a telehealth appointment without fear — that moment belongs to both of them. The kūpuna gains connection and independence. The student gains something they can't learn in a classroom: the confidence that comes from truly helping someone. That is the heart of Tech Savvy Teens. And it works.

We train students from underrepresented communities across Hawaii in digital literacy and tech support skills. Then we send them into senior centers — one on one — to meet kūpuna where they are, with patience and aloha. Many of these kūpuna are also navigating disability and isolation. For them, digital access is not a convenience. It is a lifeline.

Now we are ready to grow. This summer, we are expanding Tech Savvy Teens to new islands, new senior centers, and new student cohorts across the state. But to do it, we need to raise \$15,000 by end of summer.

Every dollar goes directly toward training students, equipping kūpuna, and bringing this program to communities that have been waiting too long. This is urgent work. Our kūpuna cannot wait, and our students are ready.

I am asking you to be part of this. Sponsor our program. Host a training. Bring our team to your living center. Or simply donate and help us show up for one more island, one more senior center, one more kūpuna who deserves to feel connected.

Together, we can bridge these generations and uplift Hawai'i. But we cannot do it without you.
