The form can be filled, saved, attached or printed, filled out and scanned into a PDF file. **Copies of membership cards and horse registration papers do NOT need to be sent** but make certain the numbers are correct and you have included 1A, etc., for Half-Arabians and CAHR or CPAR for Canadian Registry. **The ENTRY AGREEMENT page & WAIVER OF LIABILITY must be signed and submitted by all parties.** If there is no trainer, the owner/agent must sign both lines. The person who signs as trainer must be 18 or over. Parent/guardian signature is required on entry forms for juniors, or if not available, the trainer must sign as agent on the minor's behalf. (See definition of trainers and coaches in general rules) By submitting an entry to this show, it is your intent to show and agree to our rules. You agree to pay all fees due and understand that refunds will not be made.

## PAYMENT

- Entries must be paid in full. Make payment same day as you enter. You may pay by bank check, money order or PayPal. Make checks/money orders payable in US Funds to AHACO. Checks must be postmarked by May 4<sup>TH</sup> or \$20 Late Fee per horse will apply. Send fees by PayPal to [ahaco.aha@gmail.com](mailto:ahaco.aha@gmail.com). Add 4% for handling as "Friends and Family" is no longer available.
- Open checks are not allowed. If an open check is sent, it will be closed for the amount due at the time the entry is processed and deposited. Postdated checks will not be accepted.
- **At the show** exhibitors will be requested to leave an open check at check-in, before show numbers will be released, to cover post entries and other incidentals. Secretary reserves the right to finalize open checks.

## REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS

- To encourage early entries, Management agrees to cancel and refund entry and stall fees on any horse not fit to show providing written notice is given to the Show Secretary on or before the entry closing date of **May 4, 2024**
- Refunds will be considered for any horse suffering from illness or injury upon the presentation of a veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary PRIOR to **7PM Thursday, May 16, 2024**, and will be subject to mgmt. decision.
- Refunds will be considered for any exhibitor suffering from illness or injury upon the presentation of a doctor's letter to the Show Secretary PRIOR to **7PM Thursday, May 16, 2024**, and will be subject to the Management's decision.
- All other requests for refunds will be made in writing and submitted to Management for consideration.
- On approved refunds, such refund will include all fees less a \$50 cancellation fee.
- Horses may be scratched from a class or the entire show at the exhibitor's option but will not be entitled to a refund. As a COURTESY to the Gate person, Announcer and the Show Office, exhibitors are requested to notify the gate person & show office when it is necessary to scratch or cancel a class entered. This courtesy will enable the show to run more efficiently.

Please be familiar with USEF Rule Book, Chapter WD & Arabian Chapter, AR-27 Western Dressage.

A suitable western hat or protective headgear may be worn without penalty. (See GR801). **2022 Tests will be ridden.**

**Times are limited!** Entries received after closing date are not guaranteed accommodation. For that matter, neither are entries received before closing date, if all times are filled. Enter early! Classes may not be scheduled in the order published. Classes may be split or combined as entries warrant. However, a horse may only be entered in a class once, including "Test of Choice". Order of go will be assigned and posted in the Show office. Lower-level classes will be held in short court (20m x 40m); court size posted with ride times. Training devices will not be allowed in the designated dressage area at any time or in any other warm-up areas when warming up for Dressage. Due to limited ride times available, tests per horse may be limited. Entries will be accepted in the order received and when time is filled, a waiting list will be started.

## GENERAL INFORMATION & RULES

**EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. EACH PARTICIPANT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWLEDGE OF AND IS SUBJECT TO THE USEF RULE BOOK. THE USEF RULE BOOK IS AVAILABLE AT [WWW.USEF.ORG](http://WWW.USEF.ORG) THE EXECUTIVE SHOW COMMITTEE SHALL DECIDE QUESTIONS NOT COVERED BY USEF RULES AND ITS DECISIONS WILL BE FINAL.**

**AGE OF HORSES** - For horse show purposes, any horse will be deemed to be one year old on the first day of January following the actual date of foaling. A JUNIOR horse is one that is 5 years old and under.

**AMATEUR OWNER CLASSES** - Horses entered in Amateur Owner & Junior Owner must be registered in the name of the competitor of a member of the competitor's family. Contracts of sale or bill of sale will not be accepted on horses in Amateur Owner or Junior Owner Classes. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Horses registered in a farm/ ranch/ syndicate/ partnership/ corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity as defined by USEF. Also see AR110.4e for Combined Ownership rules.

**AMATEUR OWNER "FAMILY" DEFINITION** • For ownership by the same family, the term family includes the following: spouse, parent, stepparent, child, stepchild, brother, sister, half brother and sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, stepbrother and sister, grandparents and grandchildren, and in-laws of the same relation as stated above. Family also includes a cohabitant, a member of a couple who live together and have an intimate relationship without being married. See GR13 Subchapter B

**ARABIAN REGISTRATION** Horses shown in the Arabian division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association Registry and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry or, if under one year of age, be eligible for registry, and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name. Half-Arabians and Anglo Arabians must be registered with the AHA Registry in the Half-Arabian and/or the Anglo-Arabian registry or be eligible for registration and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name.

**ARENAS (SHOW AND WARM-UP)** - There are three (3) arenas for your use. The main Silverado Show Arena is 285 x 116. The Logan Arena is 200 x 120, and the Emerald Warm-Up Arena is 200 x 100. Arenas are comprised of a mixture of native soil and sand.

**AWARDS** - Ribbons, cups, or towels through sixth place in all halter and performance classes; through eighth place in AHA® Medal Classes. In CHAMPIONSHIP classes the first-place winner will be awarded a **Nifty \$50** bill

**BREEDING, IN-HAND & PERFORMANCE HALTER CLASSES** -will follow the in-ring halter procedure and will be judged using the Comparative System. The AHA Score sheet will be used for Performance Halter and Sport Horse In-Hand

**CANCELLATION OR DIVISION OF CLASSES:** The show committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide classes or make schedule changes necessary. All such changes will be announced. Any regular performance class of more than 40 horses will be split and shown in the regular schedule as duplicate sequential classes with duplicate awards. Any performance championship that reaches 40 entries will be shown as a semifinal class with horses selected by the judge for final competition. Driving and walk trot classes will be divided at the discretion of the show committee to permit maximum safety.

**CHANGES TO SCHEDULE OR VENUE.** Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges, or class order to facilitate time schedule and conditions. All changes will be posted on the announcement board at the office, and the appropriate announcements made during the competition. Classes with no entries by closing date may be cancelled. Competition management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes at its discretion for betterment of the show. Show management reserves the right to add or substitute judges as required. Upon receipt of the preliminary ride schedule, it is the rider's responsibility to notify Show Management if they are NOT eligible to show for a substitute or added judge.

**CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES:** Horses must have been entered, shown, and judged in the appropriate qualifying classes as specified in the prize list in order to be eligible to show in the championship. Qualifying classes for each Championship are shown as follows: (Q xxx). Sport Horse In-Hand Championships are awarded on high score and do not show back.

**CHANGE OF HANDLER/RIDER**• It is the obligation of the exhibitor to notify the show office of any change in rider, driver, handler or cancellation of entry and exhibitors must fill out a handler/rider change form with correct association numbers and documentation in the show office **prior to their class**. This also applies to **equitation horses** changed after entry has been processed. Changes should be submitted before the end of the session before the class is held.

**DOGS AND OTHER COMPANION ANIMALS** Dogs are allowed on leash only and never in or near the boarding barns. If a dog is found off leash, the lessee will be fined \$50 for the first offense. If the same dog is found off leash again, the owner of the dog will be required to remove the dog from the premises, and it will not be allowed to return. Exhibitors/participants must clean up after their dogs. Any feces found on the event grounds after the event will be cleaned up at the rate of \$50 per instance. No dogs are allowed in the Feed Room Restaurant and in the case that a dog is deemed to be a nuisance under ORS 609.095, the show is required to have the dog removed from the show grounds. Owners/handlers of dogs found off leash will be issued a USEF Yellow Card by the show steward or a show management team member.

**DRUG AND MEDICATION RULE:** With the exception of the fees, all rules in Chapter 4 apply. • No fee collected • All horses can be tested. The official Medication Report Form is to be filed electronically: <https://competitions.usef.org/drugs-and-meds/medication-report-form/usef>.

**GATE RULE/GATE HOLDS:** When it is found that a gate hold must be requested by an exhibitor, such request shall be made to the Paddock Master prior to the close of judging of the class immediately before the class requiring the gate hold. The reason for the request must be stated. The gate-hold will be a maximum of three (3) minutes. Appropriate warning will be given to all exhibitors if there is a gate hold in effect. AR 107.1: When horses are competing collectively, if a first horse does not enter the in-gate ready to participate within one minute from when the class is called into the ring, a warning is issued. a. Exhibitors will then have one additional minute to start the steady stream of horses into the in-gate. b. If no horses have entered the gate at the conclusion of the additional one minute, the gate shall be closed, and the class is deemed concluded. c. Once the first horse has entered the in-gate, a steady stream of horses must be maintained. d. Should the steady stream be broken after the two minutes have elapsed, the gate shall be closed, and judging will commence. e. A steady stream is defined as a constant flow of horses moving forward through the in-gate with a reasonable and safe distance between them (i.e. two to four horse or horse and buggy lengths in between). f. Show Management in conjunction with the Steward may deviate from this procedure as circumstances warrant. GR831.2: A starting order will be established in all classes in which horses compete individually and one minute allowed for an entry to enter the ring.

**HEADGEAR: (GR801)** Except as may otherwise be mandated by local law, the Federation strongly encourages all riders, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear protective headgear with harness secured which passes or surpasses ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. (Exception hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions refer to GR801.2)

## GENERAL INFORMATION & RULES

### **MOTORIZED VEHICLES (see GR1301.7 and GR1301.8)**

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, licensed competitions. Minors' scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry The blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible actions resulting from that operation. V for any damages, claims, losses, or violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited Operating such devices in areas on competition grounds. where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device the entry blank as a pa is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs rent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. mobility assistance devices for from this rule. (01/18/2023)

**NON-COMPETING HORSES** A "Plus One" horse is a horse brought to the show but not entered in any classes. A "Plus One" may be a training horse, a horse for sale or a babysitter to a competing horse. "Plus One" horses are welcome at this show as long as they adhere to the same guidelines as competing horses. must be on an official entry form with all signatures on the back of the entry form. The box for "non-Competing" must be checked. They must pay for a stall and a \$20 schooling fee per horse. They must be listed on the Stabling Request form. A non-competing horse that ultimately enters the show may have the schooling fee applied to their entry fees.

**POST ENTRIES** Horses entered **after the closing date** will pay a flat **\$20** Late Entry Fee plus all regular fees. Horses entered prior to the closing date will pay **\$5** plus entry fee to "add" a class at the show. All added classes should be entered by the last class of the session before the class is held. (i.e. in the morning for the afternoon). WD & SHIS post entries are only allowed in the event a ride/run time becomes available. Enter early!

**REFUSAL OF ENTRY:** AHACO reserves the right to refuse any entry if it is in the best interest of the horse show. The AHACO Board of Directors has directed that entries must be refused from anyone that has an outstanding obligation to AHACO.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Arabian and Half Arabian Club of Oregon, Inc. and its employees will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed, or in any way injured. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the show committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Arabian and Half Arabian Club of Oregon, Inc. against any and all loss damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs; including attorney fees which may be incurred as a result thereof. Exhibitors, grooms, handlers, owners, etc. are hereby warned that they may not use any device or conduct which may cause harm to any other person(s), horses, or equipment. Submitting the entry to the show secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing the entry.

**SAFE SPORT REQUIREMENT:** AHA will honor the SafeSport requirements and suspensions of USEF. All participants must be in compliance with SafeSport Training. Any USEF competition member of eighteen (18) years of age or older must have completed SafeSport Training prior to the first day of competition.

Participants in a Lite competition will be under the jurisdiction of the U.S. Center for SafeSport and will be subject to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code and USEF Safe Sport Policy and afforded all related protections.) Please direct any questions you have to safesport@usef.org or 859-258-2472

SafeSport Training is required for:

- Any individual signing an entry blank as Trainer or Coach, must have completed the SafeSport Training prior to the first day of Competition.
- Youth competing without a trainer or coach will have a parent sign as trainer or coach and the parent must be a USEF competing member and have completed the SafeSport training.
- Any Competing USEF Member eighteen (18) years of age or older must have completed the SafeSport Training prior to the first day of competition.
- Non-Federation members, competing members under the age of eighteen (18), Subscriber members, and Fans are not required to complete the SafeSport training.

**SHARPS CONTAINERS** will be placed in the stabling area and are to be used for disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. Improper disposal of needles and other sharp instruments subject to a fine.

**SHOW OFFICE AND REGISTRATION** - Registration at the Horse Show Office by the exhibitor is required. The Horse Show Office will be open on Thursday, May 16th at 1 PM & remain open until 9 PM. During the show, office will be open ½ hour before start of each session through ½ hour after each session ends.

**STALLIONS:** Stallions may be shown in any class except walk trot and lead line.

**TBA "BUY A CLASS"** may be sponsored for \$40 (\$50 if the class is a Championship). They will be assigned first paid first choice until all slots are filled. TBA Championships do not include purse money. The class entry fee for the TBA class is not included in the sponsorship. Additional entries into these classes may be made at the pre-entry fee for non-sponsoring exhibitors. Any class on the AHA Class List or recognized by AHA that is not on the Class Schedule will be available for TBA placement, with the exception of Dressage, Sport Horse, over fences, or any class that requires cow work.

**VETERINARIAN** -A veterinarian from Del Oeste Equine Hospital will be ON CALL. The phone is (541) 689-0205. Additional information will be posted at the show office. All animals are subject to physical inspection by the Show Veterinarian at the discretion of show management. The Show Management reserves the right to refuse entry onto the show grounds to any horse exposed to, or which may be harboring a communicable disease.

**REMINDER PER USEF RULE GR844 ALL HORSES ENTERING THE GROUNDS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY DOCUMENTATION OF EQUINE INFLUENZA VIRUS AND EQUINE HERPES VIRUS RHINOPNEUMONITIS VACCINATIONS WITHIN SIX MONTHS PRIOR TO STABLING.** Please maintain high standards of hygiene in all areas where horses reside or interact with handlers. limit access for Human-to-Horse and Horse-to-Horse contact as much as possible. ## FACILITY INFORMATION

**DRIVING DIRECTIONS:** From I-5, take the Beltline Exit (195 B) toward Junction City/Airport - approximately 6 miles. Take the NW Expressway Exit (7B). Turn right at the Stop Sign. Travel 2 miles N and look for the OHC on the right. From Hwy 99, turn E on Awbrey Lane. Travel 1 mile to the end of Awbrey and look for the OHC on the right. From Hwy 126, East on Beltline toward Junction City/Airport then same as from I-5.

**OVERNIGHT/RV PARKING** - Exhibitors may stay overnight in an RV, Trailer, or Camper in the designated RV spaces. Spaces are pre-assigned thru OHC office so check in when you get to the show for your spot. There are electrical hook-ups (limited water). Reserve your space at <https://www.oregonhorsecenter.com/where-to-stay>. If you sleep in your rig even though not hooked up, or camp in a tent you will need to contact OHC in advance of the show.

**SMOKING** is never permitted in any of the Oregon Horse Center buildings (stables, office, arenas, concourse etc.)

**SHOWING FROM TRAILERS** - Exhibitors may show from their trailers at the fee of \$25.00 PER HORSE PER DAY. Every horse is required to pay a stall fee, daily stall fee or a grounds/trailer in fee. Horses on the grounds overnight must be stalled.

**STABLING** - Regular stalls with full doors are available. Each horse must be assigned to a separate stall. Horses must be placed in the stalls assigned. No changes will be permitted without express consent of management. Bedding is not included in the stall fee. ALL BEDDING MUST BE PURCHASED ON YOUR ORIGINAL ENTRY. DELIVERIES WILL NOT BE MADE DURING THE SHOW. Other types of bedding from outside sources are not allowed. There is a charge of \$25 per stall for any exhibitor using bedding other than shavings. Tack rooms must be left clean, and trash removed, or a \$10 fee will be assessed by the facility. Every horse is required to pay a stall fee, daily stall fee or a grounds/trailer in fee. Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together should send a stabling form.

**STALL CLEANING** - Manure dumping will be at the North and South corners of the show stall barn. Barrels are placed at the end of aisles for refuse. Deposit refuse directly in barrels provided. Do not mix manure and other refuse.

After Friday noon, May 10th any additional stalls will be as space allows but not guaranteed to be located in the same group. OHC WILL DELIVER SHAVINGS only until 5 PM on May 17th. After that, no shavings may be ordered, so please plan accordingly. We recommend you order bedding with the show secretary for your late entries no later than the MORNING of May 13th

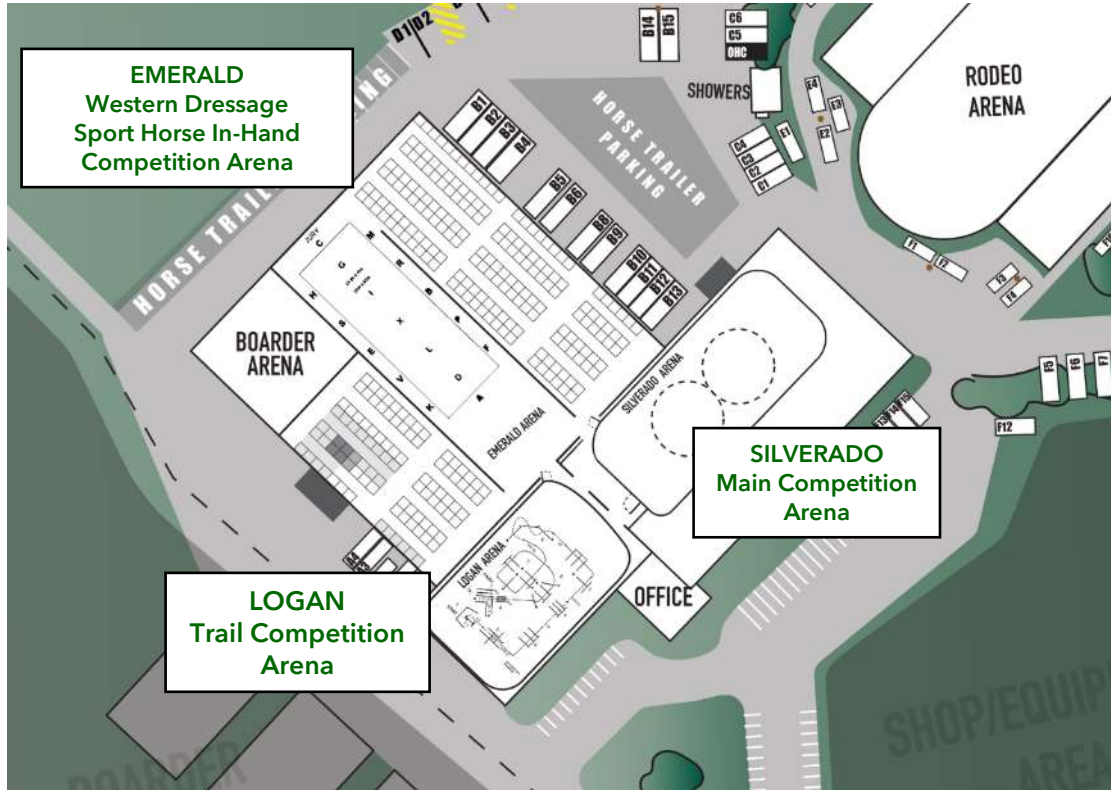

# MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

## USEF MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS FOR LITE COMPETITIONS

Trainer or Coach must be a competing member if signing an entry blank. Youth competing without a trainer or coach will have a parent sign as trainer or coach and the parent must be a competing member. A competing membership is only required for athletes seeking HOTY points. Owners seeking HOTY points must be competing members and the horse must have a recording. Show-passes are not required. All participants in a USEF Lite competition agree to becoming a USEF Fan as a condition of participation in the competition (at no cost to the participant)

## USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

**Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes**

**limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes (09/01/2023)**

**Amateur Certification • Only active Federation members may obtain amateur certification.** Every person who has reached his/her 18<sup>th</sup> birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. Only active Federation members may obtain amateur certification, Amateur cards are no longer available for non-members. Any person who has not reached his/her 19<sup>th</sup> birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur certification. An amateur continues to be such until he/she has received a change in status from the Federation. There is no fee for amateur certification for Senior Active or Life Members. Refer to GR1306 & GR1307.

**Canadian Exhibitors:** EC Sport License holders in good standing and with a Gold or Platinum Sport License (FEI Disciplines); Bronze or Silver (Eventing); or Bronze, Silver, Gold, or Platinum Sport License (non-FEI disciplines and breeds) will be given a USEF Competing Membership at no cost for the purpose of competing in USEF-licensed competitions. For information about obtaining a USEF Competition membership, EC Sport License holders contact memberservices@usef.org. You will be issued a USEF number. Use this number on your entry form. USEF rules for amateur status apply for all competitions licensed by USEF. Individuals holding dual memberships (both USEF and EC) must complete the education requirements for both National Federations

## AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

**EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)**



**AHA Competition Card Requirements •** All riders, drivers, owners, agents, and handlers who exhibit horses in the show ring or sign the entry form as the responsible party for any individual's horses at the show must be AHA **competition** level members with competition cards or pay an AHA single event membership fee of \$35. **If the recorded owner is an entity (Farm, Ranch, Syndicate, etc.) it must have a current AHA Business membership.** Exhibitors in walk trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions but must have an AHA membership with competition card at AHA regional and national competitions. Lead Line or Parent/Guardian signing for minors are exempt.

## WDAA MEMBERSHIP

A USEF/WD rule change went into effect December 1, 2021, concerning the requirement for WDAA memberships at USEF-licensed shows offering western dressage classes. The new rule WD102.8 states, "To be eligible to participate and/or compete as an exhibitor, owner, lessee, agent, coach, or trainer in any Western Dressage class or at any Western Dressage Federation Licensed Competition persons must be active members of WDAA or pay a non-member fee equal to the price of an annual membership for each competition."

This rule change means that breed shows must now verify WDAA memberships for exhibitors, owners, and trainers exhibiting in western dressage classes.

**If an exhibitor, owner, lessee, agent, coach, or trainer is not a WDAA member, they have 2 choices:**

- Join or renew online at [www.westerndressageassociation.org](http://www.westerndressageassociation.org) or join through the show by filling out a WDAA membership form completely and submitting payment through the show office \$45 for adults and \$30 for juniors.
- Pay a non-member show pass fee \$45 for adults and \$30 for juniors (junior members are as defined by USEF Rule GR128).

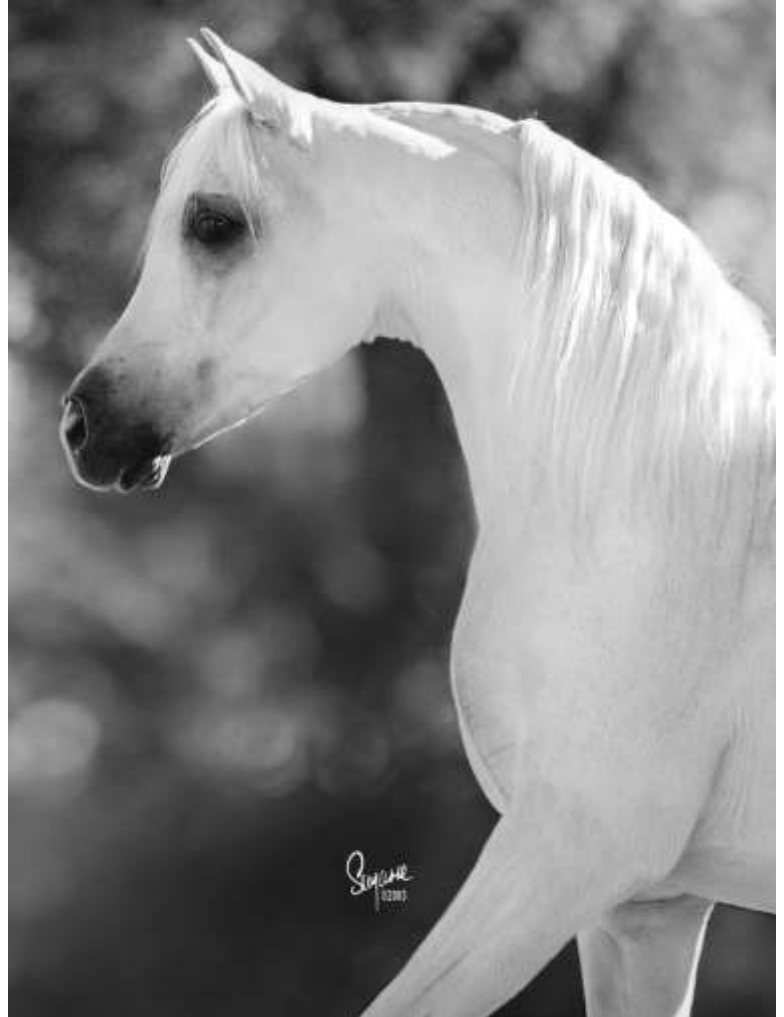

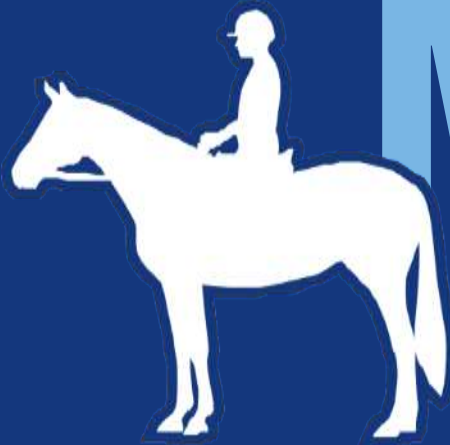
