Breeze has the look and feel of an ornamental grass, but is far tougher: extremely drought tolerant and evergreen even when temps occassionally dip into the teens. A great choice for home landscapes, streetscapes, commercial projects and anywhere a low maintenance grass is needed.



CROP TIME:

4-6 months from liners 1-gal: 3-gal: 7-9 months from liners

*depending on inputs & climate



SALES STRATEGY:

In Zones 8-11, sell as a drought-tolerant, evergreen "grass" in sizes from 1-7 gallon.

Foliage: • Fine, grassy foliage; pine-green in sunny locations and deep green when planted in shade.



Habit:

- 3 ft H x 3 ft W (+/-); tufting with an arched to weeping habit. Weeping habit in shade.
- Slow to mature; almost indeterminate growth
- Zones 7b -11; Evergreen in Zone 8

- Mass, Group or Specimen Plantings

Bloom: • Yellow-orange spike inflorescences that sit slightly above foliage in spring. Number of blooms increases significantly with age.

Notables:

·LIKES - Infrequent irrigation, filtered sunlight

· DISLIKES - Overmulching, overwatering

In Zones 8 and warmer, use as an evergreen "grass" for border, mass plantings, groupings, etc; home & commercial applications
