FREE LEGAL ADVICE IN SASKATCHEWAN



Free Legal Clinic

We operate Free Legal Clinics across Saskatchewan.

At the Free Legal Clinics, clients will receive up to one hour of free legal advice from a volunteer lawyer.

Our goal is to help people who cannot afford a lawyer get advice about their legal issue.



PBLS does not provide full representation services. This means that we do not provide every client with a lawyer who will take on their whole file.

The lawyer at the Free Legal Clinic will only provide free legal services during your appointment at the Free Legal Clinic.

Book An Appointment


- **CALL US:** Call our office 1-855-833-7257 or 306-569-3098.
- **CLIENT INTAKE:** You will have to go through our client intake. You will be asked questions about your income, assets and legal issue.
- **BOOK APPOINTMENT:** If you qualify, you will be booked an appointment. You may have to wait up to 4 weeks for an appointment.
- **CONTACT OTHER ORGANIZATIONS:** PBLS may refer you to other organizations during the intake to help deal with your legal issue and prepare for your appointment.
- **PREPARE:** Organize and prepare any important documents to bring to your appointment. You may also send your documents to the PBLS office for them to send to the volunteer lawyer ahead of the appointment.

Panel Program

PBLS's Panel Program provides an opportunity for clients to be matched with volunteer lawyers for more than free legal advice.

This program is only for certain areas of law. This program does not offer assistance in family law.

We cannot guarantee that clients will be matched with a lawyer. Clients must continue working on their file as if they will not be matched.
