Life Skills for Older Youth


Services to help with managing money, buying a car, all types of insurance, renting a home, and how to apply to college or certification program.

Programs to learn how to identify careers of interest, learn employability skills, help with career readiness, internships & apprenticeships. Job openings and job training.





Additional services for adults are classes: ESL, Zumba, Line Dance, and Spanish Literacy, and mental health first aid.


PROVISO-LEYDEN COUNCIL FOR COMMUNITY ACTION (PLCCA)


