**IN THE MATTER OF THE
BAIL/BOND SCHEDULE PROMULGATED
BY THE CHIEF JUDGE**

ORDER

WHEREAS, Sac and Fox Tribal Code Section 13-6213 provides:

The Chief Judge may establish a schedule of bail and conditions for release pending arraignment for any offense under this Code. Where a bail schedule applies to an arrested person, the person shall be promptly informed of the bail and conditions required by the schedule and defendant shall be released upon posting of that bail and agreement to the conditions.

WHEREAS, a bail/bond schedule is necessary for use when the courts are not in session.

THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority under Sac and Fox Tribal Code Section 13-6213, the Chief Judge promulgates the following bail/bond levels for the release of a person arrested for a crime other than certain mandatory arrest offenses listed below, and for use when the courts are not in session:

For a violation that constitutes:

· Class 1 Offense	\$5,000
· Class 2 Offense	\$4,000
· Class 3 Offense	\$1,000
· Class 4 Offense	\$ 500
· Class 5 Offense	\$ 400
· Class 6 Offense	\$ 300

There shall be NO BOND allowed for persons arrested for the following crimes:

- Homicide, vehicular homicide or rape
- Any offense under Chapter 6 (Assault & Battery) Chapter 7 (Abduction) or Chapter 8 (Sex Offenses) if the victim is a child or vulnerable adult or in a qualifying relationship with defendant.
- Any offense under Chapter 9 (Trespass, Mischief & Burglary) if the victim is in a qualifying relationship with defendant.
- When offense is a violation of a no-contact order based on a qualifying relationship.


Cash or surety bond shall be accepted.

This bail schedule does not apply when court is in session. Judicial officers shall have discretion in setting bail in accordance with the factors in Sac and Fox Tribal Code Section 13-6211.

An arrested person who is eligible to be released pursuant to this schedule shall be released by posting the bond indicated for the offense charged in the complaint. If the complaint contains more than one charge, the bond shall be the amount indicated for a single violation of the highest class of offense charged in the complaint regardless of the number of equal or lesser charges.

This bail/bond schedule takes effect December 9, 2010.
