## Data Centers

Join representatives from Tucker County United for a presentation and community conversation on issues related to data centers and associated microgrid power plants on January 12th, 7pm, at the Robert Byrd Center Auditorium at Shepherd University, 213 N. King St. Shepherdstown 25422. Tucker United is a coalition of Tucker County residents and allies formed in opposition to a proposed power plant and data center, advocating for transparent decision-making, sustainable land use, and the preservation of our natural resources. ## Let Your Delegate Know You're Against...

HB 4013 which would give even more tax breaks to these data centers by allowing them to dramatically reduce or even eliminate their state tax liability by deducting most of their costs from their tax bill, including capital investments, construction costs, and employee wages. This would further reduce state tax revenues, which are already decreasing, and the WV legislature has not even passed Governor Morrissey's 10% income tax cut yet. ## And Riley Moore Also...

Two new bills: SAVE America Act ([HR 7296](#)) and Make Elections Great Again (MEGA) Act ([HR 7300](#)). These bills would require every voter to show proof of citizenship, like a passport or original birth certificate, when registering to vote in federal elections. That might sound simple, but the reality is that millions of eligible voters don't have these documents readily available. Tell him you're opposed to voter suppression.
