
Hello Sopilka Families,

DANCER CODE OF CONDUCT

PLEASE REVIEW WITH YOUR DANCER!

At Sopilka Ukrainian Dance School Inc., we believe every dancer has the right to a safe, enjoyable and rich cultural experience. Dancers are only in class for a short period each week; therefore, we expect and encourage each dancer to maintain a positive and appropriate level of conduct.

Dancers are expected to:

- 1. Come to class on time ready and excited to learn and try new things
- 2. Be respectful to their teachers
- 3. Be respectful to their fellow classmates
- 4. Be respectful of the facility
- 5. Speak with kindness
- 6. Bullying will not be tolerated
- 7. Demonstrate etiquette at festivals and performances by being supportive of fellow dancers, adjudicators and other participants from other schools.
- 8. Be an ambassador for Sopilka Ukrainian Dance School Inc.

In the event that a dancer has broken the Code of Conduct:

- 1st step will include a warning
- 2nd step will involve a meeting with the required individuals including but not limited to the Parent Liaison, The Artistic Director, the Board, the dancer and the parents/guardians
- 3rd step based on the circumstances, next steps and follow-up actions will be determined

Thank you, Honourable Speaker. I am honoured to rise today to recognize Sopilka Ukrainian Dance School, which this year celebrates its 55th anniversary as a cornerstone of cultural life in South Winnipeg and beyond. Founded in 1971 by Vicky Adams as part of a Ukrainian language program at Holy Family Ukrainian Catholic Parish, the school began as the South Winnipeg School of Dance before taking on the name "Sopilka," after the traditional Ukrainian woodwind instrument. From these beginnings, Sopilka has grown into a thriving institution with more than 140 dancers, dedicated to sharing the beauty of Ukrainian heritage through dance. Since becoming a registered non-profit in 2018, Sopilka has provided high-quality instruction for dancers of all ages while fostering community pride and cultural preservation. For the past 15 years, under the arristic direction of Kristina Frykas, the school has inspired both dancers and audiences with its artistry and vision. Over the decades, Sopilka has represented Manitoba and Canada with distinction. Its dancers have performed across our province, at Canada's National Ukrainian Festival in Dauphin, at Expo '86 in Vancouver, at Vegreville's Ukrainian Pysanka Festival, and on the stage of Winnipeg's cherished Folklorama Kyiv Pavilion. They have performed for royalty, welcomed visiting officials, and shared their talent internationally in Ukraine, Brazil, and Croatia. Sopilka is more than a dance school. It is a beacon of cultural preservation and a testament to the endurance of tradition across generations. For 55 years, it has brought people together, strengthened cultural knowledge, and celebrated the vibrancy of Ukrainian identity in Manitoba. I invite all members to join me in congratulating Sopilka Ukrainian Dance School on its 55th anniversary and in wishing them continued success as they inspire new generations of dancers and community leaders.








In July 2026, our Druzi, Radist', and Spadok Ensembles will embark on a Dance Tour in Brazil to celebrate our 55th anniversary!
