COLD WEATHER & SNOW "HOUSEKEEPING RULES"

The winter weather is upon us and with that comes a change in how we enter and exit the studio. Please take the time to familiarize yourself with the expectations and to communicate this information to your dancer.

- If at all possible, please just drop off and pick up. The teachers and Kristina are more than happy to help the little ones get dressed into their outdoor clothes. The less bodies in the lobby will make for a much easier transition between each class.
- Stomp as much snow off your boots **BEFORE** entering the lobby.
- Have your dancer put their boots in the cubbies provided as much as possible. If they are full, place them on the mats to the <u>RIGHT</u> of the outside door in order to keep as much muck away from the studio as possible.
- Bring all outdoor jackets INTO the studio. Getting undressed and dressed in the studio will again, eliminate some congestion in the lobby and keep the dancers from getting a chill
- Under no circumstances are outdoor shoes to go on the blue/green mat directly outside the studio door. The rocks and salt used outside can cause extensive damage to the studio floor.

THANK YOU in advance for following these simple rules. Much time and a great deal of effort go into keeping the studio clean for everyone to enjoy!

Christmas in Ukraine

Traditionally, Christmas in Ukraine starts on January 6 (Christmas Eve in the Julian calendar). It lasts until the Feast of Epiphany on January 19. At the same time, more and more Ukrainians celebrate Christmas according to the Gregorian calendar on December 25: in 2022, 44% supported the change. Since 2017, both December 25 and January 7 are the official state holidays.

Mid-December is when the Christmas atmosphere begins to fill Ukrainian cities, with all Christmas markets and festivals, decorations and magic lights.

Christmas Eve

Christmas Eve (Holy Eve) is marked by traditional family gatherings in the evening in Ukraine – the so-called Sviata Vecheria ('Holy Dinner').

The table should be served with 12 dishes, which symbolize the twelve apostles. The main <u>dish of the evening</u> is Kutia (boiled wheat mixed with poppy seeds and honey).

Ukrainian Christmas Greetina

"Christ is Born!" and "Let us Praise Him!" are the traditional Christmas greeting. To wish each other nice winter holidays, Ukrainians also say "Happy New Year and Christmas!", "Happy upcoming holidays!" or simply "Happy holidays!".

Ukrainian Christmas Songs

You may think you don't know any Ukrainian Christmas songs. This could be true if you somehow aren't familiar with the world's most famous Christmas melody – 'Carol of the Bells'. Yes – it is, in fact, originally a Ukrainian carol called Shchedryk (composed by Mykola Leontovych at the beginning of the XX century, based on the ancient Ukrainian folk songs).
