VOLUNTEERING REQUIREMENTS

With a growing school and various events throughout the year, we require the help of volunteers from our community. We ask that families volunteer their time to work 6 hours per registered dancer (*to a maximum of 15 hours per family*) to help out at Sopilka events and activities.

As dancers get older, they can volunteer and help as well. We also welcome aunts, uncles and grandparents to assist.
