Dear Parents,

The year has gone off to a great start. Welcome to all the new families! Your dancers are wonderful additions to our community and everyone is fitting in seamlessly. I invite everyone to visit the website to familiarize yourself with the DRESS CODE. Several dancers do not have the appropriate FOOTWEAR that has been communicated repeatedly via emails, newsletters, the website and a shoe sale at Kazka in early August. We are no longer in standard black ballet shoes for several of the classes. If your child is still wearing black because they still fit, this is fine for the time being. All dancers need to have appropriate footwear by our first performance on February 7 for our 55th Gala. All boys are also expected to be in appropriate dress code and not just standard athletic wear. Girls hair MUST be secured off the face, preferably in a bun or braids.

We at Sopilka have an Artistic Team of teachers, assistants and classroom helpers, all of whom are in their position because I have full confidence in their abilities. There are times where I am not available to teach and these capable individuals will fill in in my absence. Appropriate behaviour is expected at ALL times in the classroom, regardless of who the teacher may be.

Halloween falls on a Friday this year so we invite all dancers to come to class in costumes on October 27th and 29th. No masks or weapons are permitted. Dancers must be in a costume that they are able to fully participate in.


Whether this is your first year dancing with Sopilka or your family has danced here for generations, we all share the same hope—that our school will continue to thrive for many years to come.
