KRISTINA'S KORNER

Dear Sopilka Families,

Winter has arrived and with that comes "WINTER LOBBY RULES". Please make an effort to follow the few simple rules listed so that we can keep the studio clean and warm!

- Stomp your boots off BEFORE you enter. Try your best Bukovynian stamping combination!
- Take boots off immediately and place them in the cubbies or the FAR right mats if the cubbies are full
- ABSOLUTELY NOT OUTDOOR SHOES ON THE BLUE MAT DIRECTLY OUTSIDE THE STUDIO. If you would like to watch at the door, simply take your boots off.
- All outdoor clothing is to be taken off INSIDE the studio. This is to keep the dancers warm and eliminate the congestion in the lobby
- As much as possible, please DROP AND GO. Trust the teachers to get your dancers ready for class and dressed after. We will not let them leave unless we see you. The most muck is generated by parents waiting in the lobby.
- Parents of dancers in Pershyy Krok and Sonechky are not expected to leave but are welcome to.
 Your children are cared for and in constant supervision.
- Please do not use the button to open the door.
 The door stays open for too long and causes quite a draft.

Please take the time to communicate this information with your dancer, especially those that are old enough to come in on their own.

While I know it's tempting to sneak a peek of what we are doing (Ukrainian dance is the best!), the Zabava is right around the corner and you will have an opportunity to see them dance then.

DANCE FEGTIVALG 2025

Sopilka participates in several dance festivals/competitions throughout the season. Whether your dancers is in Pershyy Krok or you are in our Krasa Adult Ensemble, you will participate in a festival.

MANITOBA UKRAINIAN DANCE FESTIVAL (MUDF)

This festival is held yearly in Winnipeg and is hosted by Troyanda Ukrainian Dance Ensemble. The festival will be held from March 14 - 16, 2025 and all classes will be expected to perform.

MUDF will be held at the Seven Oaks Performing Arts Centre, located at 711 Jefferson Avenue. The schedule for when each class will perform is released approximately 2 weeks prior to the festival and we will share that with families as soon as we receive it. Therefore, we ask that you save the dates in advance. If you know that your dancer will not be available to attend that weekend, you must inform us as soon as possible by email: sopilkawinnipeg@gmail.com.

The entry cost for the festival is \$12 per dancer, per dance and will be added to your Studio Director account for payment once it is determined the amount of dances for each class.

PAVLYCHENKO FOLKLORIQUE ENSEMBLE (PFE) DANCE SHOWCASE

This festival is held yearly in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan and is hosted by PFE. The festival runs April 23 - 27, 2025, however Sopilka will attend April 24 - 27, 2025.

The entry cost for the festival is \$12 per dancer, per dance and has been added to your Studio Director account for payment.

A block of rooms have been set aside at the Best Western Blairmore. Each family is responsible to contact the hotel and book your room under the block for Sopilka Ukrainian Dance School. The deadline to book your room is March 23, 2025.
